


# MoveMINT Dance Company 2025–2026

# Training & Classes

### Required Classes

To maintain quality technique and to progress choreography, dancers are required to take certain classes. As a dancer gets older, more training through classes and rehearsals are required. The following classes are required for each team:

### **Competition Teams\***

Tinies: One ballet class and one weekly rehearsal class

Bitties: One ballet class and one weekly rehearsal class

Minis: One ballet class, one additional technique class (jazz or contemporary), and one weekly rehearsal class

### **Convention Teams**

Petites: Two ballet classes, one jazz class, one contemporary class, and two weekly rehearsals

Intermediates: Two ballet classes, one jazz class, one contemporary class, pointe (if applicable) and two weekly rehearsals

Teens: Two ballet classes, one jazz class, one contemporary class, pointe (if applicable) and two weekly rehearsals

Seniors: Two ballet classes, one jazz class, one contemporary, pointe (if applicable) and two weekly rehearsals

<sup>\*</sup>Competition teams may be called in for mandatory Saturday rehearsals on occasion and as needed by the directors\*

#### Recommended Classes

Want to excel your training and advance at a more rapid speed? These are the recommended classes per team for dancers wanting more! These classes are required for dancers who want to compete a solo/duo/trio this season.

### **Competition Teams**

Tinies: One ballet class, one additional technique class (kidtemporary/jazz or acro), and one weekly rehearsal class

Bitties: One ballet class, one additional technique class (jazz or contemporary) and one weekly rehearsal class

Minis: One ballet class, two additional technique classes (jazz and contemporary), conditioning, and one weekly rehearsal class

### **Convention Trainees**

Convention trainees will attend 2 conventions with the MDC convention teams and have the opportunity to attend an optional convention to train alongside MDC dancers to further their craft.

Required classes: Two ballet classes, one jazz class, one contemporary class, pointe/conditioning (if applicable)

# Attendance

Regular attendance in both classes and rehearsals is pivotal for the team's success as a whole and for optimal growth as an individual. Dancers are permitted 2 excused absences from technique classes and 2 excused absences from rehearsals per semester.

Please note that "excused" means a director has been communicated with ahead of time for approval. If the dancer fails to communicate appropriately or is absent from more than the allotted amount per semester, his/her spot on the team may be jeopardized.

Attendance at ALL competition and convention events (call time, performances, classes and awards) are mandatory for all dancers attending the event.

We are proud to offer additional learning opportunities for our dancers, IN HOUSE through master classes, guest artists, and more.




# Competitions & Conventions

MoveMINT Dance Company will compete at 3 local competitions and 3 conventions, as well as perform in a company-only spring show, and in our annual Spring Concerts in May. Dance conventions provide 2–3 days of intense training with experienced dance professionals. They offer a fast-paced learning environment with numerous dancers from around the metroplex. Different years present different opportunities such as performances in the community as well as training at a variety of conventions and competitions.

\*\*\* Tinies, Bitties, and Minis will only compete at competitions, not conventions.

## Commitment

MoveMINT Dance Company dancers are making a year-long commitment to the Company Directors, as well as their teammates. By auditioning for MoveMINT Dance Company, you understand the financial and time commitment required. Parents and dancers are required to sign a contract acknowledging this commitment. Bonding events will be sprinkled in throughout the year, like a holiday or year-end banquet.



# Solo/Duet/Trio Opportunities

Solos/Duets/Trios may be available after at least one year on MDC, by approval only. Dancers are not allowed to perform additional routines without competing in group dances. Group dances are always the first priority for all dancers. Solo/Duet/Trio requests must be made by July 16th.

It is always left to the discretion of the directors as to whether or not you are ready to compete your solo/duet/trio. All solo/duo/trio participants must take the recommended classes in addition to the required classes for their team.

Choreography must be completed and set by the end of October. In November, all solos/duets/trios will perform for the directors through a "quality check". If approved, the dances can compete at upcoming competitions/conventions. If not approved, next step options will be discussed with the dancer.

**Solo/ duet/ trio cost:** Choreography plus 3 hours of rehearsal: \$450. Any additional private rehearsals will follow the studio's private pricing. Please note that opting to do a solo/duet/trio results in additional competition fees, ranging \$75-\$150/competition, and a \$110 costume fee.

Additional rehearsals must be scheduled closer to performance dates to ensure pieces are stage-ready. These rehearsals will be treated as private lessons and rehearsal fees will apply - \$50 for 30 minutes, and \$75 for an hour.

Venmo is always preferred for payment. Payments are made directly to your choreographer.

All dancers/parents will be responsible for scheduling privates with their choreographer or one of the Company Directors. These rehearsals will primarily be available on the weekends.

If your account becomes outstanding, you will not be allowed to continue with privates for a solo/duet/trio or be entered into competitions.


