## *April 4<sup>th</sup>: Costume Distribution*

Costumes will be distributed this spring if your family account balance is zero and paid in full (excluding future charges). We do have some exchanges arriving later than others. Please be patient as we prep costumes and checklists for distribution. If you have not received your costume and have not heard about an exchange, feel free to email [madigrace@studioofmovemint.com](mailto:madigrace@studioofmovemint.com) to check on your costume status.

### Costume care:

- Hang your tutus upside down to help fluff them. Many tutus also come with tulle layers that can be separated to add more fluff. You may also steam them!
- Costumes are to be worn for pictures, dress rehearsals, and recitals ONLY. They are not be worn to play in, eat in, or for any other occasion. We cannot guarantee a replacement! Please keep them in a safe place and out of reach of littles, siblings, and pets.
- Please refer to your costume sheet details for all information regarding hair, makeup, and accessories. While some costumes come with accessories (hair pieces, tiaras, gloves, etc), that does not mean we will use them on stage. Please refer to the details on your child's costume sheet. The picture is only for reference of the costume (front back,
  - Please do NOT follow the picture for hair. We pull the stock photo but that does NOT mean we intend the hair accessory placement or style to match. Again, as listed above, please read the details on the costume sheet that came with your dancer's costume.
- If your dancer is required to wear tights, your tights are included in costume delivery. We do not have extras. Please save these for recital day ONLY.
- If your dancer is in multiple classes, you might not receive ALL of their costumes at once. We are staggering deliveries all throughout the week. If your child is absent, we will get their costume to them the next time they are present.
- Your tuition and account MUST be paid in full to receive your costume(s). Please make sure your April tuition and ALL costume and recital fees have been paid.
- Your costume comes in a complimentary covering. Please transport your costume in this so it is protected to and from the theatre.

## *Required Tights & Shoes*

Tights have already been ordered for your dancer and will be delivered with their costume. Please refer to your costume sheet for shoe requirements. Please make sure to purchase those needs on your own time. We recommend The Dance Shop on Forest Park. They have all of our preferences on file and upon mentioning us, you will receive a discount.



## May 8<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> Dress Rehearsal Week

All classes will participate in a dress rehearsal at the studio during their normal class times\*. Please have your dancer arrive in costume with hair and makeup completed to the MAIN LOBBY by Pak-A-Pocket. Dancers will perform in the LAB (the big studio) without the help of the mirrors, practicing their entrances and exits. Please limit to 2 guests per student. Schedule and details to come. Bring your cameras!

*\*There are a few exceptions. Students performing with another class on stage at recital will receive an email with detailed instructions pertaining to their allocated dress rehearsal dates and times. This is important for those dancers to be successful. Please come to the correct time!*

### Dancer Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Upon arrival, please park in front of the theatre. You will enter the main entrance and find signage for dancer drop off to the right of the entrance. \*\*\*

One parent representative will need to find the security check in station. **Dancers must come ready for their first dance.** Dancers must be dropped off at the top of the act they perform in (ie: if your dancer is in the first act, they need to be dropped before the show; if they are only in the second act, you check them in at security before the show and then they need to be dropped off at intermission). Parents will stop at the dancer check in, receive a wristband with their child's name, and the dancer will be sent to their class area where faculty and assistants will take care of them. Boys will have their own assigned dressing room.

Parents are then encouraged and able to go and view our recital vendors before the theatre doors open. Signage will be at the event for assistance. *Please take your tiny dancers to the restroom before dropping them off.*

After your dancer has danced in their final dance, please head back to the security station to show your wristband and pick up your dancer. We would love for you to finish watching the show! There are loads of fun surprises. If your dancer is only in the second act and checked in, they can sit and watch the first act before being dropped off at intermission. If your dancer wants to watch any part of the recital and take up a seat, you must purchase a ticket to reserve their seat.

## FAQs

Can my child watch some of the show?

*Yes! Please! If your child is watching any part of the show, you must purchase a ticket to reserve their seat. If they are only in the first act, they can join you at intermission. If they perform in the second act- have them head back at intermission. Please be mindful we are limiting the amount of parents backstage for NUMEROUS reasons- to minimize traffic, distractions, and toddler meltdowns! Please visit with faculty to check them in or out regardless.*

Can we leave after my dancer performs?

*Please don't. Out of respect for all of the performers, please stay for the entirety of the show. Getting up and being mobile and leaving is poor audience etiquette and we want the dancers to have a full and active audience from start to finish. It is, in essence, the very point of recital! We also are teaching young theatre and dance patrons appropriate fine arts audience etiquette. We cap ALL shows at 1.5 hours to make this enjoyable for our patrons. Please stay and let your dancers soak up the performance from start to finish and support these thriving beautiful young budding artists.*

## Cast Party

*We invite our dancers and families to stick around and celebrate HeART of the West! Our recital vendors will be in the main lobby. We invite you to celebrate **in the lobby** after the show so we can prepare for the next show. Don't miss out on the fun! Feel free to visit with our vendors on site and partake in the merriMINT that follows the production.*

## Recital Items Available for Purchase

### *Tickets*

Tickets will be \$20 and must be purchased online before the show. All seating is reserved. Anyone that requires a seat will require a ticket, including performers if watching part of the show. If you have a lap child, a ticket is not necessary.

Priority tickets go on sale **April 13<sup>th</sup> at 10 AM** and can only be purchased with the unique code that will be sent from Dance Recital Ticketing to each family. An initial limit of tickets per family (listed below) will be available for purchase.

The following amounts will be available for purchase during the first round of sales, per show:

- Show A: 7 tickets per family
- Show B: 7 tickets per family
- Show C: 8 tickets per family
- Show D: 6 tickets per family
- Show E: 7 tickets per family

**On April 20<sup>th</sup>**, the remaining tickets will be available for sale for the public at 10 AM.

The purchasing link will be available on our Spring Concert webpage. Tickets can be printed from home and will be scanned at the door on the day of the performance.
