Day 1: Sunday, April 6 Lisbon Welcome to Lisbon! Art Tours

Joana Vasconcelos creates colorful, large-scale installations which often envelop everyday things decorative objects, laptops, pianos in crocheted or knitted material.. - Evening Program: Group Dinner at a traditional Portuguese restaurant enjoying the delicious food and wines from the region.












Day 3: Tuesday, April 8 Evora and Caceres

- Morning Program: Travel to the medieval town of Evora, declared by UNESCO to be a World Heritage City. In the center of it all sits the ancient Roman Temple of Évora, and down the road stands the huge Gothic Cathedral of Évora. Beyond the historic sites, Evora also boasts fantastic food and wine from nearby vineyards. Read about Evora here.
- Lunch: We will have a group lunch in Evora surrounded by historic beauty and a relaxed atmosphere.
- Late Afternoon Program: Travel to <u>Caceres.</u>, declared a World Heritage City by UNESCO in 1986 because of the city's blend of Roman, Moorish Northern Gothic and Italian Renaissance architecture. Thirty towers from the Islamic period still stand in Cáceres, of which the Torre del Bujaco is the most famous..

- Evening Program: Welcome to Madrid Cocktail Reception for the group Dinner is on your own, but we will provide recommendations and help with reservations.


Our Hotel in Madrid Hotel Hospes Puerta de Alcala

One of Spain's most beloved painters and a contemporary of John Singer Sargent, Sorolla is called The Painter of Light, and his works appear in most major museums. The museum is housed in what was the family home and it is a true gem. For more click here.
- Afternoon Program: Group Lunch at the Thyssen-Bornemisza National Museum and guided tour of the museum which holds a vast collection that traces the history of European painting from the Middle Ages to the late 20th century.
- Late Afternoon and Evening: You are free to roam, shop and dine on your own in this wonderful city. Recommendations and reservations will be provided!







Day 7: Saturday, April 12 Madrid
