- Lunch by the sea in the lovely <u>Belem</u> area where we will enjoy Portugal's amazing selection of fresh fish and seafood.
- Afternoon Program: Guided tour of the Berardo Collection Museum. The Berardo Museum has one of the world's most acclaimed modern art collections, amassed by Jose Berardo, one of the world's leading art collectors. Click <u>here</u> to access the website.

#### Day 4: Monday, May 27 Lisbon *The famous Gulbenkian Museum and Free Afternoon*



- Evening Program: Group Dinner in one of Lisbon's excellent restaurants near the city center.






#### Day 5: Tuesday, May 28 Lisbon – Evora – Caceres – On the Road to Madrid!

- Morning Program: Travel to the medieval town of Evora, declared by UNESCO to be a World Heritage City. Nestled in Portugal's agrarian heartland of Alentejo, Évora charms travelers with its off-the-beaten-path appeal and historic heritage. In the center of it all sits the ancient Roman Temple of Évora, and down the road stands the huge Gothic Cathedral of Évora. Beyond the historic sites, Evora also boasts fantastic food and wine from nearby vineyards. Read about Evora <u>here</u>.
- Lunch: The Palacio de Cadaval is known for its architectural grandeur and embodiment of Portuguese culture. Located in front of the Roman Temple, the Palace is a singular example of the country's architectural heritage, resulting from a unique combination of Mudéjar, Gothic and Manueline styles. It also houses the well-known restaurant Cavlarica where we will have our group lunch. Read more about the palace <u>here</u> and about the restaurant <u>here</u>.
- Late Afternoon Program: Travel to <u>Caceres.</u>, declared a World Heritage City by UNESCO in 1986 because of the city's blend of Roman, Moorish Northern Gothic and Italian Renaissance architecture. Thirty towers from the Islamic period still stand in Cáceres, of which the Torre del Bujaco is the most famous.
- Evening Program: Group dinner at our hotel in the outskirts of Caceres.








Day 6: Wednesday, May 29 Caceres -Trujillo -Madrid *Contemporary art in medieval cities along our way to Madrid*

- Morning Program: guided visit of The Museo Joaquin Sorolla. One of Spain's most beloved painters and a contemporary of John Singer Sargent, Sorolla is called The Painter of Light, and his works appear in most major museums. - Afternoon Program: Group Lunch at the Thyssen-Bornemisza National Museum and guided tour of the museum which holds a vast collection that traces the history of European painting from the Middle Ages to the late 20th century.
- Late Afternoon and Evening: You are free to roam, shop and dine on your own in this wonderful city. Recommendations and reservations will be provided!







Day 9: Saturday, June 1 Madrid *Our last day to explore*!
