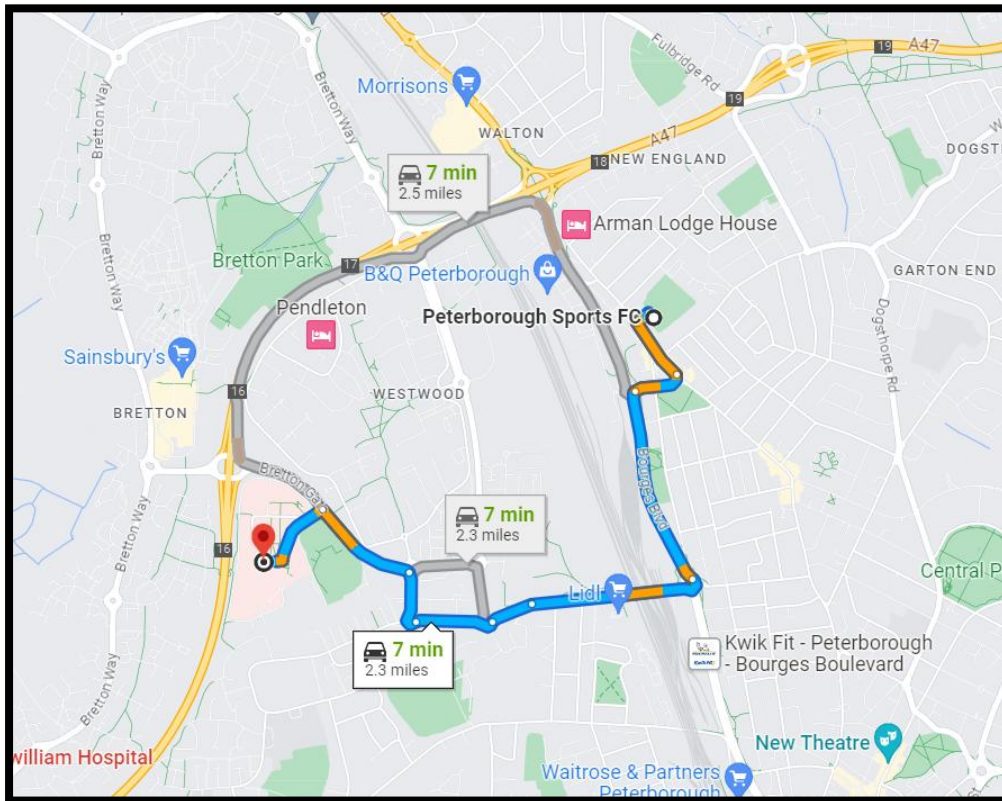

Single gate by Turnstiles access from the front of the ground.

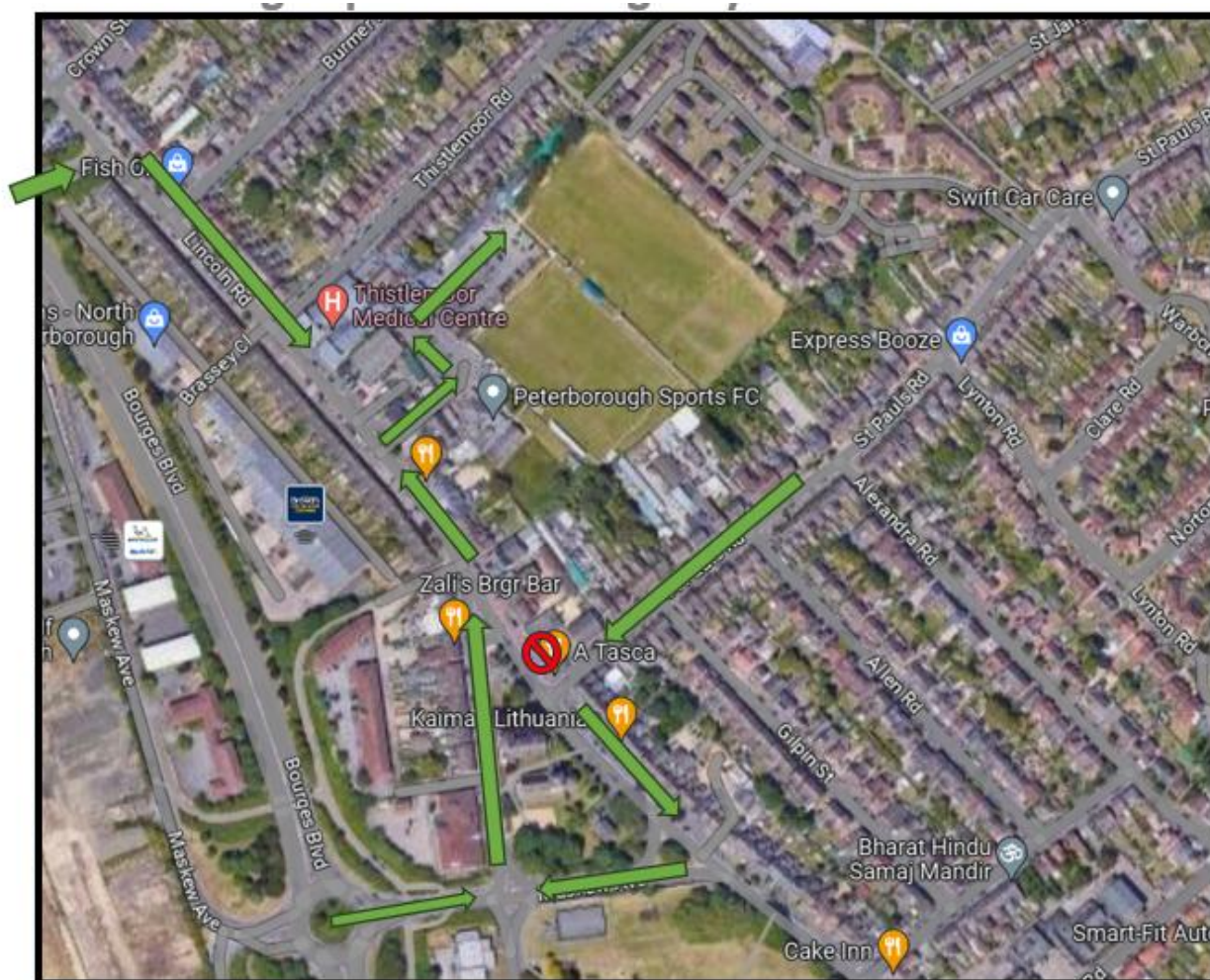

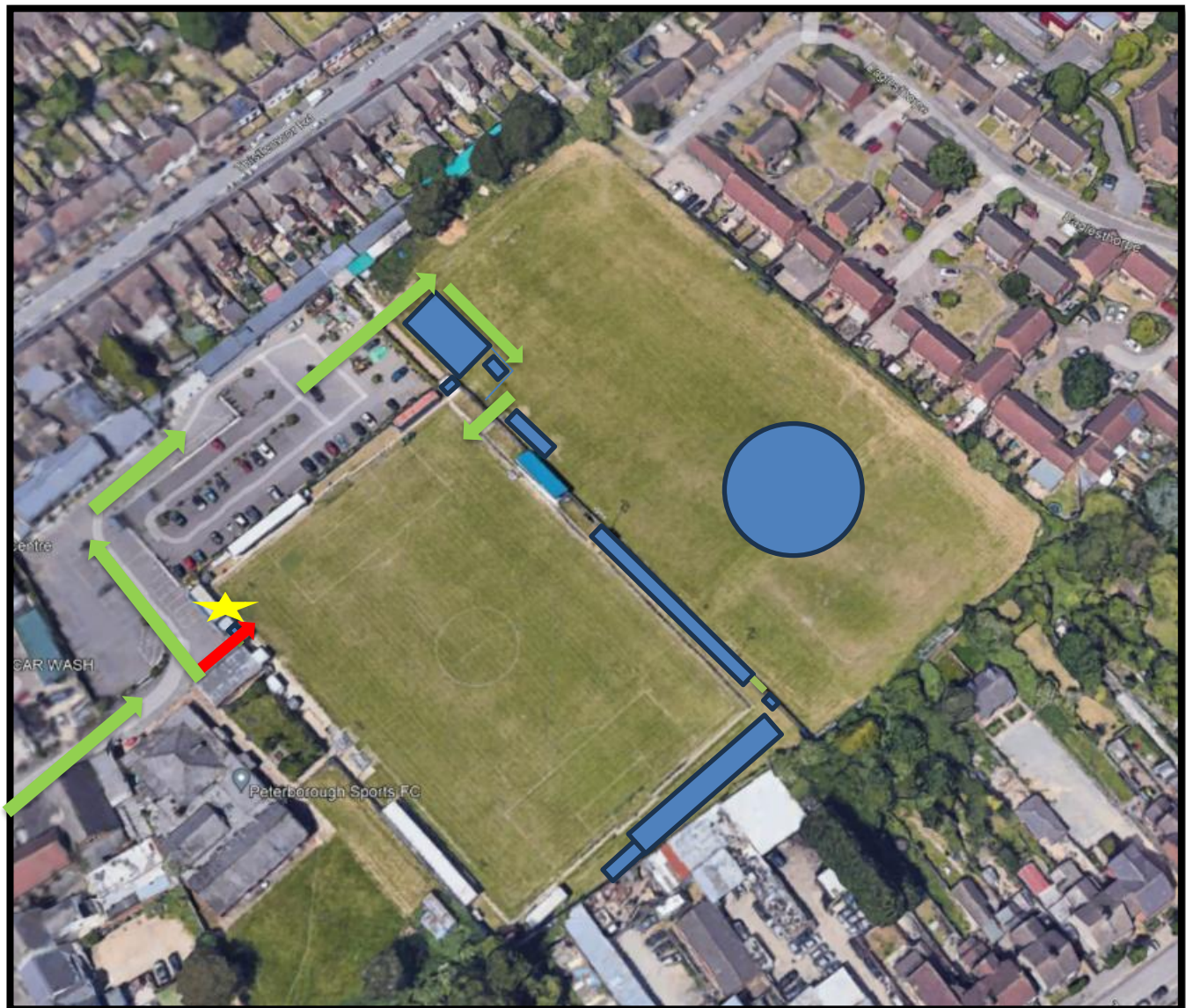
