Greetings Faith Family,

February is an important month in the life of Belden Baptist Church. On February 1, we will host our Ministry and Missions Fair, and I want to encourage every member and family to see this as more than an event—it is an invitation to Kingdom living.

Jesus reminds us in Matthew 6:33, “*But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you.*” Kingdom living is not passive. It’s not simply attending worship or agreeing with truth—it’s actively aligning our lives with God’s purposes. The Ministry and Missions Fair is one of the clearest ways we can take a step from spectator to servant.
