From the Pastor's Pen,

Spring is blooming out all around us! Baseball, crappie fishing, turkey hunting, yard work, redbud trees, dog wood trees, Day-Light Savings, and warmer weather. In all of the excitement, I want us to get ready for Easter, which is the last Sunday in March.

Holy Week is March 24-31. Spend time this week reflecting on the Sacrificial Lamb of God who gave is life so that you may be saved. Be intentional about praying for lost friends and family by name. Share the gospel with them. Invite them to church and Sunday School.

This Easter we are wanting everyone to invite their friends and family to Sunday School. Usually on Easter we will have a large attendance in worship. 
