Getting to San Pedro

BY PLANE

- Catch a connecting municipal flight from the international airport out to the island of Ambergris Caye. Simply email us your international flight itinerary and the names of everyone in your group. Our team will arrange your flights and the taxi transfer to the resort, which is included in the price of the airfare ticket when you purchase with us.
- The tickets include:
 - 1 personal item (15 lbs)
 - 2 checked bags (50lbs)
 - Free changes up to 1 hour before departure time on the same booking class
 - Cancellations made within 24 hours of the flight are 50% refundable, although they become non-refundable after flight departure.

Flats Fishing

Flats Fishing can be done in a wide variety of flats varying in composition from white sand, to coral patches to eel grass covered areas. You may choose to cast from the boat as your guide poles the flats or "hop out" of the boat to get a better casting position. Fish can be found on these flats in abundant numbers. You get to cast up to 20 tailing fish on an average day. Bonefish are also plentiful on the more sandy flats in this area. Don't miss out on the experience of Belize fishing at its best!

Mainland Tours

3 in 1 Combo Tour Xunantunich Mayan Temple

Fly to Belize City where your tour guide will meet you and escort you through Belize's beautiful countryside. Your first stop is at Xunantunich Temple. You will cross the river to Xunantunich on a hand cranked ferry, climb this 130 feet Mayan Castle and enjoy a breathtaking view of the Mopan, Macal, Belize River Valleys and the Guatemalan border.

Next stop is the caves systems for your other 2 activities; zip lining and cave tubing. Zip line through the jungle tree tops high above the forest floor through 6 different platforms and enjoy a bird's eye view of our pristine ecosystem. Lunch will follow after this activity.

Cave tubing follows next! Get ready for a 20 minutes walk and then float on your tubes through the river that disappear into the underworld caves that are filled with 1,000 year old pottery shards, statues of fertility gods and Mayan footprints. This day will be unforgettable and an adventure to talk about when you return home.

Belize Zoo and Cave Tubing

Visit the famous Belize Zoo, and experience over 170 animals living in their natural habitat. The Belize Zoo houses animals which were orphaned, rescued, born at the zoo, rehabilitated, or sent to the Belize Zoo as donations from other zoological institutions. Then float along the river-way at Belize's Caves.

ATM Cave – Actun Tunichil Muknal

Fly to Belize City and journey to the Cayo District to explore one of Belize's most visited underworld Mayan Caves. The ATM cave is about a 45 minute drive off the Western Highway in the village of Tea Kettle. From the ATM's parking lot, expect a 45 minute hike through the jungle along the rivers to the cave entrance. You will have to swim across the crystal clearwater to explore the caving portion of the tour. Once in the cave you will find the remnants of Mayan Rituals and Ceremonies arranged just as they were left thousands of years earlier by the Maya. Do not let this opportunity pass by as you will have memories to last a lifetime.
