Kennel Quilts - Stephany Wisecarver

Hi Quilters! Another bang up haul from the April meeting — 33 pet quilts and 3 fleecies! Sincerest thanks to all those who participate in many ways— from donating materials, cutting fabric, sewing kits, to distributing our finished products to the various shelters!

Just a reminder - kennel quilts are 12"x18", no binding, sewn and quilted with small (2 mm stitches), made from any washable fabric with no loosely woven threads for animals to catch their paws on. Fleecies are fringed approximately 20 inch squares. Flannels are enveloped, same finish and dimensions and also stitched about 2 " from each side.


