

Cesar Chavez & Dolores Huerta Holiday Parade & Festival 2026

San Francisco's Annual Cesar E. Chavez & Dolores Huerta Holiday Parade & Festival is a significant community event in the City's Mission neighborhood that celebrates the life and legacy of Cesar E. Chavez (3/31/27-4/23/93), and United Farm Workers Co-Founder, Dolores Huerta. Cesar & Dolores inspired farm workers and millions of people who never worked on a farm to commit themselves to social, economic and civil rights activism.

Cesar & Dolores' legacy continues to educate, inspire and empower people from all walks of life. They are role models for all Americans and for generations to come.

The culturally diverse event draws audiences from San Francisco and the Bay Area, and has become the largest celebrated Cesar E. Chavez community event in Northern California.

The event begins with a Parade and March from Dolores Park, a historical Mission neighborhood park. The Parade is led by the Latino Honor Students from San Francisco/Bay Area public schools carrying their school banners; followed by community based organizations, labor unions, community leaders, elected officials, floats inspired by the UFW movement, musicians, dancers, and Classic cars. Hundreds of supporters march through the Mission Neighborhood ending on 24th Street at the Cesar Chavez & Dolores Huerta Day Festival.

The Festival includes family entertainment, cultural dance and music, a Children's Area, a Classic Car Show, arts & crafts vendors, local community resources and information booths. Merchants will have sidewalk sales; and food will be provided by local restaurants. The 2026 Festival highlights include two stages: Main Stage at 24th St/Bryant; and Youth Stage & entertainment at 24th St/Harrison St.

The Cesar Chavez & Dolores Huerta Day Committee is partnering with the Latin American Teachers Association (LATA); the San Francisco Labor Council; and the Mission Artist Coalition (MAC) to make this a family and community event.

Thousands attend the Annual Cesar Chavez & Dolores Huerta Holiday Celebration--families, students, artists, community based organizations, labor unions, community leaders, elected officials, schools, business, corporate partners, and many more.
