

#### Lead Team December 17th

Meeting started at 5:01

Mac called to order and was designated as a chair for the evening.

Minutes reviewed, and Joe motioned to approve, bill seconds all approve vote carried.

New business - Melynda wants to get gift cards for staff, prior years and current motion for \$100 per employee, second by steve. All approved vote.

UMM - monthly breakfast and after the meeting a discussion was had about making some donations to Good Sam, Isaiah House, Agape, and Angel tree with the school. Bathroom, fellowship hall, sunday school room, playground fence, landscaping, sanctuary repairs etc. discussion about pulling the carpet from the steps on the alter entrances to make safer to walk possibly. PSK checks HVAC in parsonage and boyscout room. Discussion about winterizing parsonage, water turned off but need to turn off water heaters? Or turn water back on. Discussion about possible space use for parsonage. Housing homeless would be just a cold weather thing, make dinner and breakfast and make sure they have a warm place to sleep but then send them on their way the next day. There are requirements and legal questions, but using the gym basement.

Get a hold of WRUS about possibly ending contract with them


