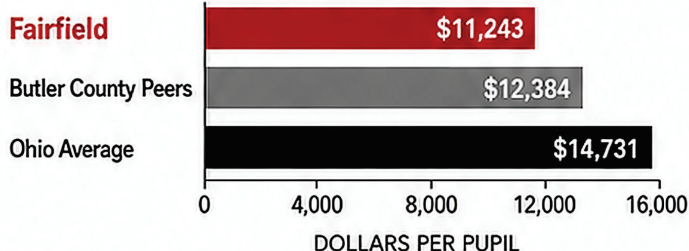
1 Lower Cost Per Pupil

2 Lean Administration

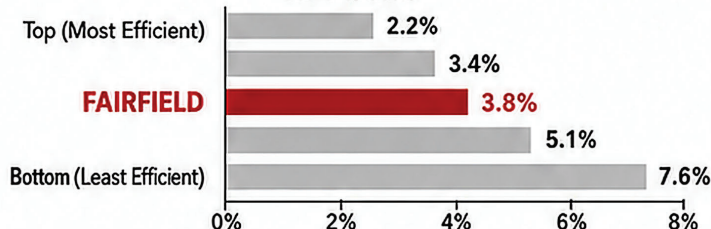


5th lowest administrative spending share

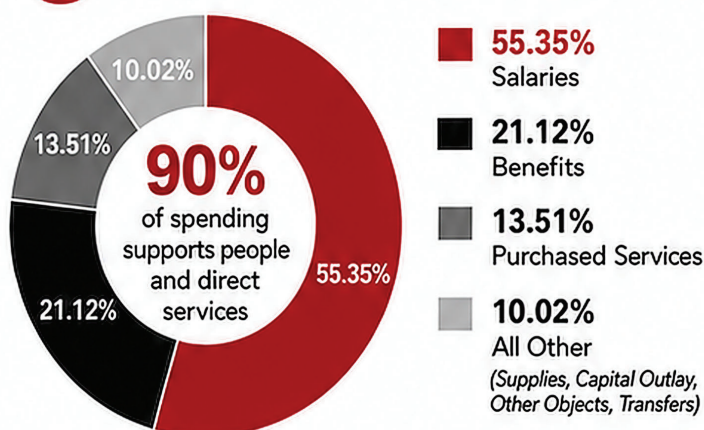
Among 32 school districts in Butler and Hamilton Counties, Fairfield ranks near the bottom in the share of spending devoted to administration.
