

MULCH CONVERSION CHART

For a brand new bed with no existing mulch, a depth of 3-4" is preferred to establish a good base of mulch. For a bed that already has mulch a depth of 2" is probably sufficient. The chart below helps when you have bagged or bulk mulch and will give a guide as to how many are needed
