From timeless masters to groundbreaking innovators, each featured composer has left a lasting legacy that continues to inspire new generations. We invite you to explore their stories and celebrate the musical eras they represent as you enjoy today's performances.

JOHANN SEBASTIAN BACH (1685–1750) A MASTER OF THE BAROQUE ERA, STILL CELEBRATED FOR HIS INTRICATE COUNTERPOINT AND DEEP MUSICAL EXPRESSION.

PHILIPP EMANUEL BACH (1714–1788), THE SON OF J.S. BACH, A KEY FIGURE IN THE TRANSITION FROM THE BAROQUE TO THE CLASSICAL PERIOD.

WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART (1756–1791) A CHILD PRODIGY AND PIONEER OF THE CLASSICAL ERA. MOZART COMPOSED OVER 600 WORKS ACROSS NEARLY EVERY GENRE.

FRÉDÉRIC CHOPIN (1810–1849) A ROMANTIC-ERA COMPOSER AND VIRTUOSO PIANIST BEST KNOWN FOR HIS POETIC AND EXPRESSIVE PIANO WORKS.

PYOTR ILYICH TCHAIKOVSKY (1840–1893) A ROMANTIC RUSSIAN COMPOSER WHOSE EMOTIONALLY CHARGED MUSIC INCLUDES SWAN LAKE AND THE NUTCRACKER.

**SERGEI RACHMANINOFF (1873–1943)** A RUSSIAN COMPOSER, PIANIST, AND CONDUCTOR, WIDELY REGARDED AS ONE OF THE GREATEST MUSICIANS OF THE LATE ROMANTIC PERIOD.

FRIEDRICH "FRITZ" KREISLER (1875 – 1962) AN AUSTRIAN-BORN AMERICAN VIOLINIST AND COMPOSER. ONE OF THE MOST NOTED VIOLIN MASTERS OF HIS DAY, HE WAS KNOWN FOR HIS SWEET TONE AND EXPRESSIVE PHRASING, WITH MARKED PORTAMENTO AND RUBATOS.

MANUEL DE FALLA (1876–1946) A LEADING SPANISH COMPOSER OF THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY. DE FALLA INFUSED CLASSICAL MUSIC WITH SPAIN'S RICH FOLK TRADITIONS.

WILHELM KEMPFF (1895–1991) PRIMARILY KNOWN AS A PIANIST, BUT HE WAS ALSO A COMPOSER WHO BROUGHT POETIC DEPTH TO HIS INTERPRETATIONS OF BEETHOVEN AND SCHUBERT.

**DMITRI SHOSTAKOVICH (1906–1975)** A TOWERING FIGURE IN 20TH-CENTURY SOVIET MUSIC WHOSE WORKS REFLECT PERSONAL STRUGGLE AND POLITICAL TENSION.

GEORGE GERSHWIN (1898–1937) CREATED A UNIQUELY AMERICAN SOUND BY BLENDING CLASSICAL MUSIC WITH JAZZ AND POPULAR STYLES.

**EARL WILD (1915–2010)** BOTH A VIRTUOSO PIANIST AND COMPOSER. WILD WAS KNOWN FOR HIS DAZZLING TECHNIQUE AND TRANSCRIPTIONS OF JAZZ AND CLASSICAL WORKS.

SAMUEL OSMOND BARBER II (1910 –1981) AN AMERICAN COMPOSER, PIANIST, CONDUCTOR, BARITONE, AND MUSIC EDUCATOR, AND ONE OF THE MOST CELEBRATED COMPOSERS OF THE MID-20TH CENTURY.

**KEITH JARRETT (B. 1945)** AN INNOVATIVE JAZZ AND CLASSICAL PIANIST, RENOWNED FOR HIS IMPROVISATIONAL GENIUS.

### MEET THE YOUNG PERFORMERS 2025




#### ISABELLA BARLIS (AGE 15)
