The Adventures of Healing and New Life Services Policy 2025

1. Group Attendance

- Requirement: Members must attend group meetings twice per month.
- Consequences of Non-Attendance:
 - Failure to attend without reasonable explanation will result in temporary removal from the group.
 - Members removed from the group must schedule a one-on-one meeting with the group leader.

2. Volunteering

- Requirement: All volunteers must complete the required training before participating.
- Consequence: Individuals who have not completed the training will not be permitted to volunteer.

3. Group Apparel

- Requirement: All active members must wear a shirt with the business name. (Only when volunteering)
- Ordering: Shirts must be ordered through the group.
- Inquiries: Contact the group leader with any questions regarding shirt orders.

4. Social Events

- Mandatory Monthly Events: Starting January 2025, the group will host a mandatory "Ladies' Night Out" or "Family Night Out" each month.
- Purpose: To foster social interaction and community within the group.

5. Retreat

- Dates: April 5th - 6th, 2025

- Location: Front Beach House, Lake Erie
- Eligibility: Previous members who have already paid for the retreat are eligible to attend. Anyone else that wants to attend, Contact the group leader
- Reading Material: (Be Made Whole) 3 copies are left that can be used Contact the group leader.

6. Policy Acknowledgement

- Deadline: January 3, 2025
- Consequence: Members who have not signed and returned this policy by the deadline will be removed from the group.
