He travels and teaches classes for ASM in Failure Analysis, Corrosion, Welding and Metallurgy for the Non-Metallurgist. Mr. Bell served on the Board of Directors for AWS from 1992 to 2004. He has held Level III certifications in methods: MT, VT and PT in accordance with ASNT-SNT-TC1A.

Mr. Bell's consulting business is in failure analysis, welding, and corrosion evaluation, located in San Diego. NDT is a key step in conducting a good Metallurgical Failure Analysis.

Title of the his talk is: "Role of NDT in Metallurgical Failure Analysis" This presentation will cover case histories in Metallurgical Failure Analysis and how the use of NDT has been an important step in the solution of problems in machinery, weldments, structures and pipelines. The advances in NDT have made better manufacturing processes for metals, perhaps even more than advances in metallurgy.
