In the past few weeks, the RSCA has seen a significant increase in reports of noise disturbances, acts of vandalism, and threatening behaviour in our community at all hours of the day and especially late at night.

With the above in mind, we would like to remind residents that as per the City of Ottawa Parks and Facilities Bylaw all parks have an 11pm curfew. We would also ask residents to report to the appropriate authorities when incidents like this occur as neighbourhood patrols are report-based:
