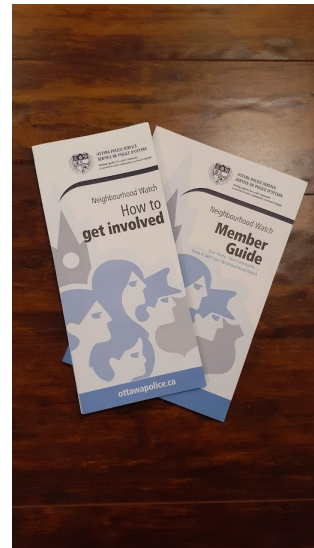
Launching a Neighbourhood Watch

As you know, crime does happen in Riverside South. Recently, we've seen more cars stolen from driveways, and other dangerous incidents including graffiti, vandalism, and even attacks on young people. While an increased police presence can help deter crime in the area, police cannot do that alone.

A large number of RSS residents are looking to start a formal Neighbourhood Watch. Led by the advice of the Ottawa Police Service, a Watch is one of the

easiest ways to help protect yourselves and your neighbors from criminal activity. At its core, a Neighbourhood Watch is about getting to know the people who live on your street, and building relationships so you can more easily recognize when something might be going wrong.

We will have an online public meeting with Kyle McDonald, who is the Neighbourhood Watch coordinator for the Ottawa Police Service. Kyle will explain how to get the program started, and answer anyone's questions about the program, how it works, and how it can benefit our neighbours.
