Canada Day is always our biggest event of the year, and our goal is to make 2025 even more memorable than years past!

Enjoy inflatables, miniature train ride, rock climbing wall, laser tag, mini golf, human foosball, dunk tank, shows by Little Ray's and Junkyard Symphony, toddler zone, live DJ, face painting, balloon clowns, and more!

Food trucks will be on site again this year; enjoy options from Royi Street Cart, Domino's Pizza, Kona Ice, and Le Donut Stop. We will also have snacks and drinks available for purchase at our fieldhouse canteen next to the splash pad. *Please note that the canteen is cash only.*

Fun passes for unlimited access to the rides and entertainment only cost \$16 in advance (or \$18 at the event, *cash only*) for ages 3+. Individuals not going on rides and toddlers under 3 years old are free.

Ticket portal now open. The portal will close at midnight June 30. Fun passes can be purchased on site Tuesday, July 1 with *cash only*.

8-10pm: Join us at Claudette Cain Park on July 1 for a professional fireworks display sponsored by the Riverside South Limited Partnership (Urbandale, Richcraft, and HN Homes)!

Enjoy music starting at 8 pm and fireworks will begin at dusk (approx. 10 pm).
