The OCDSB planning department is looking for community feedback on the proposed options for alleviating the overcrowding at Vimy Ridge Public School - they would like to hear from you BEFORE April 5.



One of those options would see VRPS grade 7 & 8 students bussed to Steve Maclean PS (which itself is also over capacity) and potentially up to a total of 12 portables on site which would mean the loss of the school soccer field as well as a change to SMPS bell times (10 minute later start).

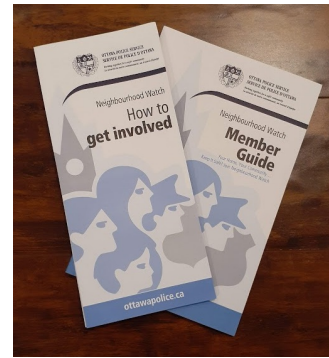
