1515 Earl Armstrong Road Site Plan Application

The RSCA has received notice of a Plan of Subdivision application for 1515 Earl Armstrong Road.



The subdivision application has been

submitted to permit the development of 1 new public road that will connect Earl Armstrong Road to Limebank Road, and for 3 development blocks for commercial and retail development. The proposed development would permit the future development, through the site plan

control process, of 12 buildings with associated surface vehicular and bicycle parking. Landscaping around and within the site is proposed, as is a pedestrain connection at the north of the site to connect with the pathway around the stormwater management pond.


