Riverside South Residents Q&A

Sometimes we receive questions from residents through our social media channels or website. Here are 2 recent questions and the answers we received from the Councillor's office.

Q: What is the status of the proposed retail development at the northeast corner of Limebank and Earl Armstrong?

A: The site plan approval has lapsed. If they wish to continue with the project they need to apply to the planning department to officially extend the approvals of this site plan. If they choose not to extend their approvals it simply means there is no active approval for a Food Basics on this land, and a building permit cannot be issued until they have a valid site plan approval for the property. The reason for the delay was not shared by the planner with our office and the application has not reached out to us for assistance.

Q: When will the new community centre and library be built?

A: It looks like the timeline has been extended, but do not have a date range to share.
