Community Centre & Library Public Engagement Session

That Future Community Centre & Library? The City Wants Your Input!



The **City of Ottawa** is hosting a public engagement session to gather feedback on the **future Riverside South Community Centre, Library, and district park** planned near Limebank Station. If you've got ideas about what this new community hub should include, this is your chance to share them.

City of Ottawa Public Engagement Session

Tuesday, March 24

Rideauview Community Centre (Gym) - 4310 Shoreline Dr

7:00-8:30 pm (presentation at 7:30)

The project will bring together a **community centre and library under one roof**, surrounded by a district park with **sports fields, a splash pad, playground, and walking paths**. In other words... a future neighbourhood hangout for learning, playing, and inevitably

running into someone you know.

To help prepare for the City's session, the **Riverside South Community Association (RSCA)** ran a quick community survey to get a sense of what residents are hoping to see.

And wow... you showed up.

We had **192 respondents**, which officially makes it **our most engaged survey ever**.

Here are a few highlights:

Library Love

- 92.7% say they'll use the library
- 40.1% expect to visit at least once a week

Community Centre Demand

- 97.4% say they'll use the new community centre
- 42.7% say they'll be there weekly

Translation: this place is going to be busy.

Getting There & Green Space

- About **two-thirds** of respondents say they'll visit **without a car at least some of the time**
- About **two-thirds** also said **native plants and trees** are important in the landscaping

So yes... people want great programming **and** a welcoming green space.
