Trail Rules and Guidelines

1. Must bring your own horse. Trailers will not have “hook up” abilities.
2. Ride at your Own RISK. Muhle farms/Granville County Equestrians is not liable for any personal injury, property etc. Anyone 18 yrs or younger is suggested to wear an accredited riding helmet.
3. Management reserves the right to qualify the ability of riders and to excuse any rider from participation beyond the riders’ abilities.
4. Management also reserves the right to qualify the suitability of all horses and to excuse any horse from participation if it is deemed that participation may jeopardize the safety of the rider or other riders on the trail.
5. Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed on the ride.
6. All riders must stay behind the trail guide. No rough-riding or racing is permitted.
7. Stallions and dogs are not allowed.
8. In order to warn other riders, a red ribbon should be tied on the tails of horses that are prone to kick.
9. All horses should be appropriately shod or have suitable hoof protection.
10. Be sure your horse is fit, conditioned and able to handle the rigors of the terrain safely.
11. Muhle Farms Inc rides require that all horses have a negative Coggins. Please see state regulations for the time frame on Coggins testing. Out of state attendees will require vaccine records, and highly suggested for all attendees to have their horses up to date. Please submit all Coggins along with registration to Kristen Akers at Granvillecountyequestrians@gmail.com
12. No smoking on the ride. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only.

13. No ponied or loose horses allowed on ride.

14. No littering on the trail, ample amount of trash cans and trash bags will be provided at the "camp/break" area

15. Camping for Friday night only is allowed (no electrical hook ups, can bring generators , must have temp pens for your horses) Friday check in starts at 5pm-9pm. Absolutely NO FIRES on the premisis, Camping will be in open fields.

16. On Saturday Gates open at 8:30am, opening statements at 9:45am, 3-hour trail, will start at 10 am. lunch will be around 1pm and final 2-hour trail will end around 3:30pm.

17. Wagons are not Permitted. We apologize but the terrains can be too narrow and steep for wagons.

18. Spectator tickets can be purchased as well, must fill out registration to enter and recieve meal tickets.

19. Pre Register ends - June 3rd 2022.
