Meanwhile, housing demands, supply shortages, and migrating populations are on the minds of government representatives and in the eyes of developers across Tennessee. Knee-jerk, short-sighted solutions that will harm West Hills and every neighborhood and community across the state are being proposed.

A recent example happened in mid-January. Senator Richard Briggs, one of the two state senators representing West Hills and west Knoxville neighborhoods, sponsored a bill to deny public input during the local review process.

After constituents expressed overwhelming opposition to the legislation, he withdrew his sponsorship. Hopefully, no other senator will fill the void and the bill will die. WHCA continues to monitor any similar legislative activity in Nashville.

Meanwhile closer to home Planning Commissioners have asked staff to prepare legislation to remove existing local ordinances restricting duplex and multiunit construction in single-family residential zoning—the majority of West Hills zoning.

Your WHCA continues its 61-year tradition to be the neighborhood's advocate. It is committed to preserving the integrity of the community and fundamental right for individuals and groups to participate in all stages of the review process of proposed land developments.

Three West Hills Land Development Plans

- 1. The development by Homestead Land Holdings at the corner of Middlebrook and Broome Rd appears to be moving forward since the developer recently completed the purchase of the property from the Moody trust. You will recall the developer plans to construct 28 townhouses on the property with an entrance from Broome Rd. Anticipate land clearing to begin in January 2025 depending on the weather. WHCA registered concerns with the City regarding the creation of a hazardous traffic condition due to the short distance between the entrance to the townhouses and Middlebrook Pike.
- 2. The proposed development by Homestead Land Holdings at

Gallaher View and Middlebrook Pike has been withdrawn from consideration by Homestead for development of this property. The property was successfully rezoned RN 4 (C). The impact of the "C" (Pre-Recode planned residential) designation is uncertain, but may have contributed to the developer's decision not to pursue development of this property.

3. A proposed development of the forested area between the Greenway and the Interstate south of St Andrews subdivision was subject of a meeting last fall between a St Andrews home owner association representative, WHCA representative and the developer's attorney. No new information is available as to the scope of the proposed development or the project's anticipated schedule. Development of the area will adversely impact the greenway and further increase flooding in St Andrews.


