Last Tuesday City Council voted at its second hearing of the One Year Plan with the amendment to remove the duplex location standard in Special Use zoning applications in RN-1 and RN-2 zoned properties like West Hills..

First, by law and prescribed in our city charter, City Council must approve the annual land use plan called for the City called the One Year Plan (OYP).

If the Council so chooses, it may add an amendment or multiple amendments to the OYP.

In **January** Planning Commissioners asked Planning staff to review one item in all the zoning ordinances: the duplex location standard requirement in Special Use zoning in RN-1 and RN-2 neighborhoods like West Hills.

In **February** staff responded that the duplex location standard was not necessary. In **March** PC voted to remove the standard, **April 1** City Council voted 8-1 to repeal the standard (BTW, it's for both new construction and conversion of existing single-family homes).

The lone vote to deny removing the standard was at-large member **Lynne Fugate**.

Our community association reached out to the West Hills neighborhood to inform and encourage comments be sent to council members.

And you did and so did others across the city.


On **April 29** City Council held the second hearing. The debate was lively and it appeared council members were more engaged than at the first hearing.

The result was not the victory we had sought, but was positive in the sense that three additional votes to deny the duplex location repeal were picked-up resulting in a 4-4 tie (one council member was absent). The mayor broke the tie with her vote to approve the OYP and remove the duplex location standard.

Your voice and emails mattered last week and affected the final vote. You were mentioned more than once as "one neighborhood" was heard from frequently.

We may not win every time, but we sure will try. **Thank you, WH neighbors!**


