Byzantine Chant

O Gladsome Light, known in Greek as the Phos Hilaron, is an ancient hymn that originates from the 3rd or 4th Century. It is one of the earliest known Christian hymns and is typically sung during evening services, though we are making an exception and singing it during morning worship as a way to celebrate the musical culture of our brethren from the Eastern Orthodox tradition.

O Gladsome Light of the Holy Glory
Of the Immortal Father,
Heavenly, Holy, Blessed, O Jesus Christ!
Now that we have come
To the setting of the sun
And behold the light of evening
We praise God:
Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
