

Big Mountain Firewise

WILDFIRE SEASON – Annually April-October

Post in clear view on refrigerator or bulletin board!

Fire Danger Rating System:

Low (Green) Fire starts are unlikely.

Moderate (Blue) Some wildfires may be expected. Take routine caution.

High (Yellow) Wildfires are likely. Outdoor burning restricted

Very High (Orange) Fires start easily and may spread faster.

Extreme (Red) Fires start and spread rapidly. No outdoor burning

- Use caution & common sense before lighting a fire. Any fire or spark can become a wildfire.
- Never leave a fire unattended. Make sure a fire is completely extinguished.
- **Fireworks are not allowed!**
- Properly extinguish and dispose of all smoking materials.

In the Event of a Wildfire

- Stay aware of the latest news and updates from local media and the Fire Department
- Leave Early! Changes in fire conditions can change rapidly.
- Park your car facing out. Place valuable in the car. Have your car keys close by
- Dress appropriately. Sturdy shoes, long pants and shirt, and a handkerchief
- Leave electricity and some lights on
- Close shutters, blinds, heavy drapes
- Shut all doors and windows. Leave doors unlocked.
- Place a note on the front door stating names of all evacuees, as well as the date and time of evacuation, your destination and contact information.
