Complaints regarding dog feces not being picked up on Cascade Ct. need proof such as video, not just neighbor to neighbor conversations.

ARC- Georgia Dardick provided approvals and will be out of town next week.

Violations 8 and 9 were closed; more violations were written.

COWBRA- Has filed a vehement opposition with the City of Boynton Beach regarding the annexation of 33 communities currently in unincorporated Palm Beach County. The membership fee has been paid for BWHOA.

Discussion regarding the proliferation of iguanas. The Board had previously hired an iguana removal company which cost and estimated @\$3200.00.

General Comments/Questions:

Clarification on how far Country Fair mows- They only have water rights for irrigation. The contractor kills vegetation to the waters edge. The HOA was dissolved and it is now managed by Jillson Mgmt (?)

What are the parking regulations? — Currently even side of street only, no blocking of sidewalk, special requests can be made for parking on the grass on the north easterly side of Aqua Vista Blvd.. It is the homeowners responsibility to provide for their guests whether on the driveway or by request to the HOA via APM. No onstreet parking between midnight to 5 am..
