We also want to pass on some information about some maintenance and improvement projects proposed for the Northwest Lift. There is a summary below but you can click <u>HERE</u> to see the Scoping Letter from Mt Bachelor to the Deschutes National Forest. The maintenance items include:

- Replace buried power supply line from Road 21 junction box to power transformer at base of lift.
- Bury 5000 feet of currently exposed communication and fiber lines beneath the NW lift to prevent freezing.

· Replace operator shacks at top and bottom of lift.

The proposed improvements are:

- Expand chair storage area at bottom of lift to hold all chairs. This would allow installation of a night drive system which would allow the lift to run in "creep mode" to reduce ice buildup.
- Add a 20 x 20 prefab steel maintenance shop at base of lift.
