


## BEND SKI CLUB MONTHLY NEWSLETTER FEBRUARY 2020

## **BREAKING NEWS/USEFUL INFORMATION:**

#### **RECENT SKI TRIP:**

Eight of our BSC members have just returned from a fabulous week of skiing and apres fun at Big Sky Resort in Montana (FWSA Annual Ski Week). We had 14 inches of new snow, reasonable temps and NO lift lines. The mountain is huge with 38 lifts on a total of 3479 acres. There is also a tram which services expert skiing only, including triple black diamonds. Turtle, Laury and Marlene had a bit of excitement on a scenic tram excursion. Ask us about it at the next ski get together!! We encourage more members to attend next year's Ski Week. The destination is Sun Valley, January 30th to Feb. 6, 2021. Info on this trip will come out in June or July of this year. One of BSC's board members, Rod Robinson is the leader for this trip. DON"T MISS THE FUN!!!

- --SAFETY On the Mountain: I think we are all aware of some of the hazards we skiers need to be aware of during our play time on the snow. One, of course, is the threat of tree wells, sadly brought to light with deaths and near deaths on Mt. Bachelor the past couple of seasons. Besides always skiing with buddies when off-piste, everyone should have a whistle handy, dangling from their outer jacket. The BSC offers free logo-ed whistles to all members, available for pick up at all Off-Mountain events and occasionally On-Mountain meetups. The proper procedure for using these if in trouble on the mountain is to give 3 short blasts, interrupted by a few seconds each. Of course, if in doubt, just blast away until found, and keep your fellow ski buddies in sight at all times when skiing off-piste, and especially in the trees!
- --Coffee-On-The-Mountain informal get togethers every day, Pine Marten Lodge, 11:30 12ish, downstairs table by Pinnacles Coffee Shop: DO check in if you are in a meetup group or not, as we have established that time period/location as a possible meeting point for club members on the mountain, looking for other members to ski or just chat!
- --Ski Club 'Ski Connections' Program: All dues-paying members will soon receive an <u>updated</u> participating fellow members contact list, including their self-described ski ability, to facilitate finding ski companions to ski with when there may be no compatible meetups scheduled for that particular day.
