**Ascension Day** 

In the midst of the church calendar, there's a significant day often overshadowed this time of year. It lacks the fanfare of resurrection and the fervor of Pentecost. Yet, it's a day etched in the disciples' memory: the Ascension of our Lord.

Celebrated on the 40th day of Easter, the second Thursday before Pentecost (this year May 9), the Ascension marks Christ's return to heaven. It's a solemn occasion affirming Christ's reign over life and death, a silent proclamation of Christ's resurrection.

"Then [Jesus] led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven." (Luke 24:50-51)

Imagine the disciples' emotions as they watched Jesus vanish from their midst. No more touching his wounds or sharing meals by the fire. The world changed in an instant. Yet, amidst their confusion, they received a promise: the Holy Spirit, empowering them to carry on Christ's ministry of spreading the Good News.

Ascension Day initiates a relay of faith—a baton passed from Christ to his followers. It's as if Jesus said, "It's your turn now. Carry this message of hope to all." Though tempted to search the skies for Christ's return, the disciples are reminded to see Christ's presence among themselves, as they proclaim Easter's Good News. The responsibility now falls on their shoulders.

This relay stretches across centuries, as each generation passes Christ's love to the next. The baton is now in our hands. With the Holy Spirit's fire, we're part of this eternal relay, spreading Christ's message wherever we go.

#### Roof Loan Update

Our Line of Credit, when all roof repairs were completed was \$98,258.00. Since then we have been making principal payments using offerings from the congregation after reaching a certain amount. We have lowered the principal amount to \$72,385.70 as of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Thank you! The Lower we can get the principal the less we will pay for the interest over the life of the loan when it begins in July. If you were wanting to make a one-time offering for 2024, and have the funds available, please make it before June 15<sup>th</sup> so we can lower the principal even more.




## Fellowship for Single Women
