When Jesus sent out the 72 disciple makers, they came back rejoicing at the wonder of God in their mission. In the same way, our 86 church planters came back rejoicing at the wonder of God through our efforts by taking the hopeful and life-changing message of Jesus to the ends of Ghana!. Following Jesus' directive to sow seeds of the Good News and foster these seeds through intentional relationships, we've witnessed substantial growth, acknowledging that Christ is the ultimate source of that growth. Implementing the Disciple Making Movement (DMM) has allowed us to share the Gospel with over 350 individuals monthly and establish numerous discovery Bible study groups throughout Ghana. Through God's provision, we not only exceeded our initial goal of planting 130 strong churches in 2023, but established a total of 138 churches. Remarkably, over 3,255 individuals embraced Christ through baptism. Our monthly training sessions for church planters served as a valuable source of strength and camaraderie. In 2023, our efforts extended to positively impact over 80,000 people involved in the churches planted.

This year, our hospital has catered to over 9,500 individuals facing a spectrum of medical situations, ranging from urgent cases like minor infections to critical scenarios such as childbirth and surgeries. Additionally, we have extended free health insurance coverage to 5% of the population.

Operating our hospital poses significant challenges within our ministry. These challenges include demands of consistent influx of resources for recruiting and retaining medical professionals, maintaining pharmacy supplies, securing non-drug consumables, and navigating interactions with government insurance programs and regulatory bodies.

In a dedicated effort this year, we prioritized settling major banking debts to enable a sustained focus on providing quality and affordable healthcare to our patients in the future.

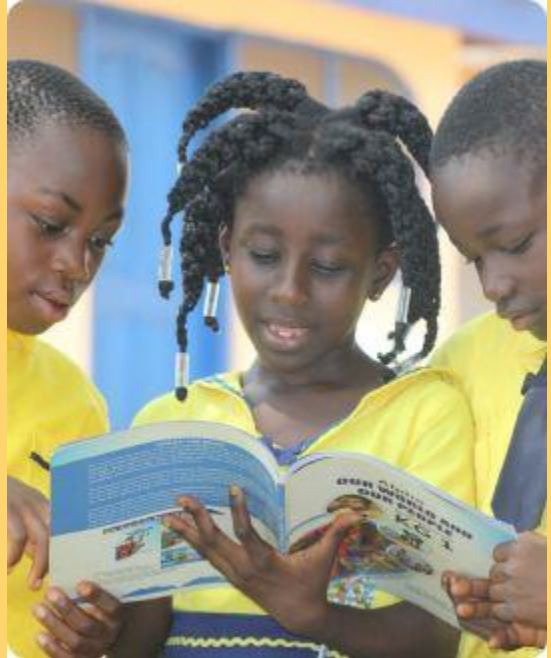

Our ministry oversees the operations of four educational institutions: Adaase Basic School, Kayreku Basic School, Ateiku Basic School, and Ateiku High School. These campuses collectively cater to over 1,000 students, providing them with a high-quality education centered around Christian values. In the year 2023, 9% of our students were beneficiaries of various scholarship programs, with 6% receiving full-ride scholarships generously funded by our donors. 40% of the students at Ateiku Basic and Ateiku High School are boarding students, primarily hailing from areas beyond the immediate vicinity of Ateiku.

A significant accomplishment was marked by Ateiku High School in 2022, as it achieved a remarkable 100% pass rate on the West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASCE). Our educational curriculum extends beyond the conventional subjects, encompassing a diverse range, including science, business, agriculture, general arts, and home economics. Our overarching goal in education is to create opportunities that foster positive transformations in both the communities we serve and the lives of the individuals within them.

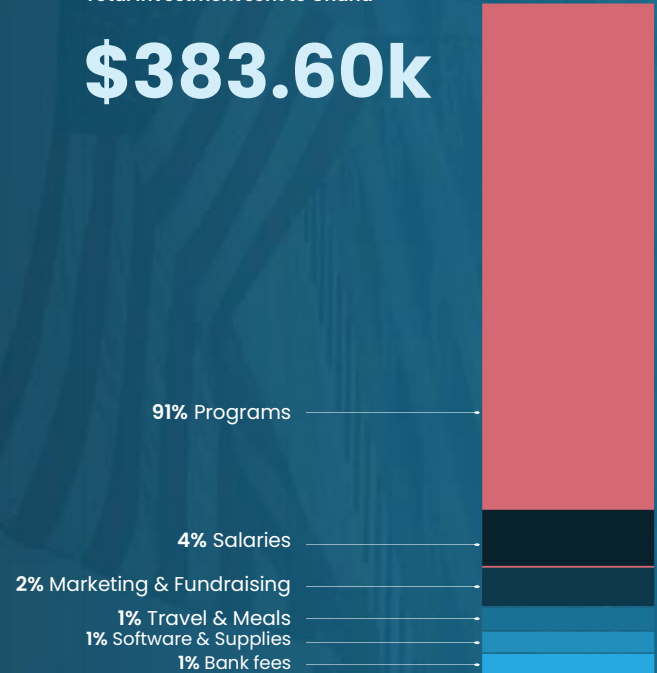

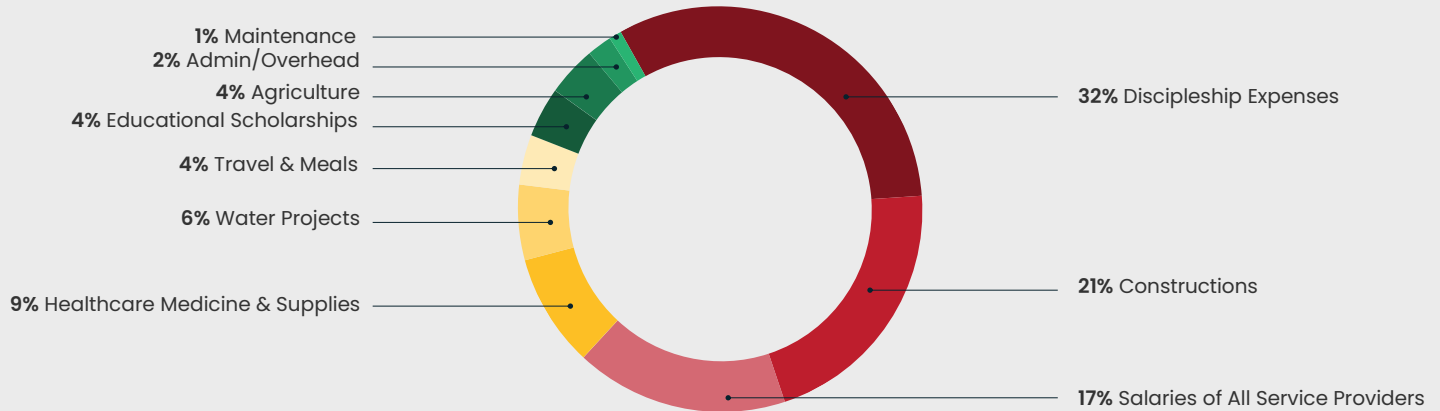
