CAN I OFFER YOU SOME WATER?

As a guest, when you first enter the home of a Ghanaian, they offer you the best seat in the house. Before asking any questions concerning reasons for your visit, they offer you the best drink they have – often, it is clean water. The question, “Can I offer you some water?” not only reflects the practicality of quenching the traveler’s thirst, but comes with the pride of being able to offer something that meets a need, expresses hospitality, and exudes dignity for the host. However, for many rural Ghanaians, the opportunity to host a special guest goes hand in hand with anxiety because they often have to go purchase filtered bagged water or bottled water to ensure their guest has something better than the stream or groundwater they themselves drink daily. Providing access to clean filtered water in rural communities often goes beyond meeting the need for water. It serves as a way to extend hospitality to those families who, in turn, can be gracious hosts for their guests.

When Jesus of Nazareth began his public ministry, he uttered these words in a public reading: “the spirit of God is on Me because he has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor, he has sent Me to proclaim freedom for the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to release the oppressed, and to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.” As part of this mandate, Jesus made it clear that whoever drinks from the water he gives shall never thirst but will be like a spring of living water. The Lord of hosts extends hospitality to all of us by offering each of us the fountain of living water, so that those who receive it can offer unto others that which we have received.

Therefore, as we participate in the ongoing, everlasting ministry of Jesus Christ, we share the hope, love, and future of the Gospel with all its rights, privileges and commitments with the people we serve. In so doing, God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit is honored by the fruits that come out of this ministry. We proclaim that the Lord’s favor was upon us in 2022 and will be upon us in 2023.

We recognize and employ the humility of Paul in reporting about all of our work, but especially in the area of disciples. Jesus has called us to plant seeds in the hearts of men about the Good News and water those seeds through nurturing intentional relationships; the growth comes from Christ alone. Since we began implementing the Disciple Making Movement (DMM), we are sharing the Gospel with over 350 new people each month and forming many discovery Bible study groups all over Ghana. God's provision meant surpassing our original goal of planting 150 strong churches by 32, for a total of 182 churches planted this year. Over 3,200 people gave themselves to Christ through baptism. Our monthly training and encouragement sessions for church planters were a great source of strength and comradery. Overall, we were able to serve over 72,000 people in the communities we work with in 2022.



This year, our hospital served over 8,500 clients in situations ranging from urgent, like minor infections, to critical, like baby deliveries and surgeries. We also provided 280 people with free health insurance. In addition, an installation of solar panels helped us to maintain a relatively consistent electricity flow and to cut back on our energy costs by 70%. Our hospital proves to be one of the more challenging aspects of our ministry. Its operation requires a continuous flow of resources to hire and retain doctors and nurses, stock the pharmacy, ascertain non-drug consumables, and interface with government insurance programs and regulatory bodies. This year, we made concerted efforts to clear our major banking debts so that we can continue to focus our resources on delivering quality and affordable healthcare to our clients moving forward.

Our ministry oversees four schools: Adaase Basic School, Kayreku Basic School, Ateiku Basic School and Ateiku High School. Over 1,000 students receive Christ centered quality education amongst these four campuses. About 55% of our students received some level of scholarships in 2022; 15% attended on a full ride scholarship thanks to the generosity of our donors. 46% of the students at Ateiku Basic and Ateiku High reside on campus as boarding students during the school semesters; these are typically those from outside the immediate Ateiku areas.

In 2022, Ateiku High School proudly recorded a 100% pass rate on the West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASCE). Beyond the traditional curriculum, students have the opportunity to learn about science, business, agriculture, general arts and home economics. Our educational goal continues to be about creating opportunities that change our communities and our people.


GHANA FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN


