- ✚ It is required to complete the C.A.N.T.S. Form, which will be sent to the Dept. of Children & Family Services. A favorable form must be returned to allow adult to participate in any MAYN programs. In addition, volunteer agrees to subsequent background check every 5 years. Conviction of a felony will be grounds for dismissal as a mentor.
- ✚ It is required that the mentor keeps all information confidential except when abuse, harm, or neglect is suspected. In this case, refer to MAYN’s Suspected Abuse or Neglect Policy.
