Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective, employed by the Travis County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas.

On 6/30/2017, [Redacted] (age 17) was arrested for multiple charges to include Assault with Injury – Family Violence, Criminal Trespass – Family Violence, and Criminal Mischief – Family Violence. Subsequent to his arrest, [Redacted] was issued an Emergency Protective Order (C1CR17151971) on 7/3/2017 which, among other provisions, was ordered to have no communication with the victim except through an attorney or a person appointed by the Court. This Order was signed by Austin Municipal Court Magistrate S. Vigoritto and also showed [Redacted]'s signature acknowledging receipt of the Order. The Order indicates it shall remain in effect until midnight on 9/3/2017.

Affiant reviewed two calls made by [Redacted] to his family member on 7/12/2017 while he was incarcerated at the Travis County Jail located at 500 W. 10th Street. During the contact he told his relative to call "my girl" and "old girl" and the family member placed the call to the victim (age 15) via speaker phone so she could facilitate [Redacted]'s ability to talk to the victim as he instructed. Affiant has reviewed multiple prior calls in which [Redacted] has repeatedly stated he was prohibited from having contact with the victim, naming her by name. Affiant has personally interacted with the victim and recognized her voice to be the same as the third party who was called. Affiant further confirmed her identity via context of the call to include the victim referencing her own name.

An investigation of this incident revealed [Redacted] intentionally or knowingly violated an Emergency Protective Order when he communicated with the victim contrary to the Order which prohibited such.

Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective employed by the Travis County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff's Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

Travis County Sheriff's Office records show ██████████ was arrested on 11/9/2017 on a warrant for Assault with Injury – Family Violence against his girlfriend/mother of his child (A.P., female, age 20) in cause #C1CR17153237. Subsequent to this arrest, ██████████ was served an Emergency Protective Order in the same cause. In addition to her provisions, Austin Municipal Court Judge R. Meyerson ordered, "No Communication with the victim or a member of the family or household of a protected person, except through the party's attorney or a person appointed by the court." The order was signed on 11/10/2017 and showed ██████████ acknowledged receipt of the Order this same date at 2:02pm.

Affiant reviewed jail phone calls made by ██████████ while in custody and found he made a total of 8 completed calls to the listed protected party (A.P., female, age 20) in direct violation to the aforementioned Order between the time the Order was served through 11/13/2017. Affiant was able to verify the number called belonged to the protected party as it matched the name and cell phone listed for her in reports, the name and cell phone number listed as ██████████'s emergency contact in jail files, and registered by name and phone number in the Securus phone system. The calls are detailed as:

- 11/10/2017: 2 completed calls
- 11/11/2017: 4 completed calls / 27 attempted calls
- 11/12/2017: 2 completed calls / 9 attempted calls
- 11/13/2017: 5 attempted calls

Affiant asked jail personnel to place an administrative block so that Joshua could not continue to violate the Order.

Affiant was able to determine the person called is the same as the protected party based on the context of the calls and in both parties use of each other's name. ██████████ told the protected party not to tell anyone she was talking to him and cautioned the protected party the calls were being monitored. One of the calls was made using another inmate's account which Affiant has commonly seen with inmates attempting to hide their communications. ██████████ questioned the protected party about her report to law enforcement and CPS and the occurrences in their household in his absence throughout the calls.

██████████ currently has two pending family violence related offenses to include the aforementioned case for Assault with Injury – Family Violence and a prior arrest for Interference with an Emergency Call. Additionally he has two other misdemeanor cases pending for DWI, and Theft. He is currently on probation in Williamson County and has an active warrant for a parole violation out of New Hampshire. Information was received during the investigation of the aforementioned incident that he has also been fabricating breath samples for mandatory breathalyzer testing.

Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective, employed by the Travis County Sheriff’s Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff’s Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

Travis County Sheriff’s Office records indicate deputies ██████████ (male, age 34) was arrested on 11/1/2018 after the victim (C. M., female, age 30) called 911 three separate times reporting unwanted contact from him after he showed up at her residence uninvited and unannounced. The victim reported she and ██████████ were previously in a dating relationship for about 1 year. His charges include Criminal Trespassing and Harassment.

Subsequent to his arrest, ██████████ was issued an Emergency Protective Order (cause number C1CR18152030 and C1CR18152031) on 11/6/2018 by Judge J. Meeker (JP5) to remain in effect until 1/5/2019. Among other standard provisions, Judge Meeker ordered ██████████ was not to have any contact with the alleged victim. ██████████ signed acknowledging he received a copy of the Order.

Affiant searched the Securus jail phone system and found a call placed to the victim’s phone number. Upon review of the call, Affiant recognized the victim’s voice based on Affiant’s prior personal phone contact with her as well as the context of the call. During the call ██████████ was insistent he was “coming home” to her when he’s released from jail even though she told him repeatedly he was not returning to her home. At one point he told her, “Eventually, yes I am”. When he told her he loved her, she asked him to stop telling her that and disconnected the call.

The victim told Affiant previously she no longer wanted contact with ██████████ and wanted him to forget her. She also said he has exhibited “stalker intentions”. Securus records show ██████████ has attempted to call the victim 92 separate times since the protective order was issued. Affiant requested jail staff block the victim’s number to prevent further violations.

██████████’s CCH records show the below convictions as an adult:

- Attempted Agg Sexual Assault of Child
- Fail to Register as Sex Offender
- Reckless Driving
- DWI
- Assault Causes Bodily Injury Family Member

██████████ is currently required to register as a sex offender until 11/4/2021.

Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective, employed by the Travis County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff's Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

On 2/7/2019, Affiant was notified by jail staff there was suspicion [Redacted] was contacting the protected party (K. C., female, age 38) of an active Emergency Protective Order (EPO). Affiant researched [Redacted]'s jail records and found he was being held on charges for an assault involving strangulation in cause #D1DC19200346. Affiant reviewed the EPO in this same cause number and found in addition to standard provisions, Austin Municipal Court Magistrate Stan Kerr ordered [Redacted] was prohibited from communicating with the protected party except through an attorney or a person appointed by the Court.

Affiant searched Securus jail phone records using the protected party's listed phone number. Records showed the protected party's name was associated with the account information connected to the phone number and call logs showed 83 calls were made to this number from [Redacted]'s account from 1/16/2019 to 1/22/2019. A review of [Redacted]'s calls to the victim included the parties discussing the no communication Order and Affiant was able to confirm the party called as the victim through context of the calls and subsequently recognition of her voice. Affiant blocked phone numbers on 6 occasions to attempt to prevent [Redacted] from continuing to violate the EPO and it should be noted his acts included using the accounts of other inmates as means to conceal the violations.

[Redacted]'s criminal history records show he's previously been convicted twice for an assault against a family member.

An investigation of this incident revealed [Redacted] committed an offense when he knowingly or intentionally communicated with a protected party in direct violation of an active Emergency Protective Order which prohibited all communication except through an attorney or designated party.

Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective, employed by the Travis County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff's Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

Travis County Sheriff's Office records show ██████████ (male, age 47) was arrested on 5/28/2019 for an assault involving strangulation and suffocation as well as interfering with an emergency call. Subsequent to his arrest, ██████████ was served with an Emergency Protective Order in cause #D1D19203760 by Austin Municipal Court Magistrate C. Harris-Schultz on 5/29/2019. Among other standard provisions Judge Harris-Schultz ordered good cause was found to prohibit ██████████ from all communication with the protected party (T. G., female, age 44) except through an attorney or person appointed by the Court. Judge Harris-Schultz signed the Order on 5/29/2019 to remain in effect until 7/29/2019. ██████████ signed acknowledging he received a copy of the order this same date.

Affiant conducted a search of Securus jail phone records using the victim's phone number and located a total of 6 calls made by ██████████ to the victim on 5/30/2019. Affiant reviewed these calls and was able to additionally recognize the called party to be the victim/protected person based on ██████████'s use of her first name, context of the calls, and voice recognition. ██████████'s contact with the victim included the below:

- Made multiple statements blaming her for his arrest and attributes his behavior to her inability to listen to him
- Gave her instructions to receive his calls and/or put money on his account
- Talked over her and became explosive and/or scolded her when she didn't acquiesce the conversation to him, spoke to him in an unfavorable tone, and/or contradicted him
- Told her to "shut the fuck up" when she mentioned the incident leading to his arrest
- Gave repeated instructions to call an attorney on his behalf and blamed her for the attorney not responding to her
- Discussed a non-prosecution affidavit
- Told her, "I'm not sorry for shit!"
- Told her, "Quit running your fucking mouth" when she expressed being scared and afraid of him
- Accused her of lying and spending time with others while he's in jail and made her swear "on the kids" she was being truthful
- Berated and yelled at her for not doing what he asked her to do
- Continuously redirected the conversation to getting him out of jail
- Called the victim a "snitch ass bitch" for talking about the incident leading to his arrest
- Told her she had "no business calling 911" during the incident
- Told her the fact she called 911 meant she didn't care about him
- Made statements as if to normalize what occurred after the victim told him she did not want to continue their relationship because of what he'd done to her. He stated, "So what? That happens in relationships. So what?"

Throughout the calls, the victim expressed multiple times she feared ██████████ and was scared and worried what he might do when he was released from jail. Since his release on 6/1/2019, deputies have responded to the victim's residence twice on reports related to potential protective order violations.

In an Assault Victim Statement completed during the strangulation/suffocation investigation, the victim answered yes to the below questions:

- Has the suspect ever threatened you if you call the police? (reply: him and his family)
- Were you prohibited from making an emergency call for assistance? (reply: took phone)
- Do you want an Emergency Protective Order

The victim also answered yes to the below 7 of 13 Lethality screening questions indicating a high risk of further/escalated violence:

- Do you think he might kill you? (reply: "After today, yeah")
- Has he ever choked you before? (reply: "Not before today")
- Is he violently or constantly jealous or does he control most of your daily activities?
- Is he unemployed?
- Do you have a child that he knows is not his?
- Does he follow or spy on you or leave threatening messages?
- Is there anything else that worries you about your safety? (Reply: "his family")

Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective, employed by the Travis County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff's Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

Travis County Sheriff's Office records show deputies arrested ██████████ (male, age 53) on 6/14/2019 on a warrant for an assault involving strangulation from an incident occurring on 3/2/2019. Subsequent to his arrest ██████████ was served with an Emergency Protective Order in cause #D1DC19500145 which showed Austin Municipal Magistrate R. Meyerson, in addition to other standard provisions, ordered ██████████ was to have no communication with the victim except through an attorney or person appointed by the Court. The Order was signed on 6/15/2019 to remain in effect until 8/15/2019 and ██████████ signed he received a copy on 6/15/2019.

Affiant was contacted by the victim (L. T., female, age 54) on 7/8/2019 as part of an ongoing investigation. The victim reported she received text messages from a friend of ██████████'s only know as "Paul". She provided Affiant a screenshot of the text message which read,

- "Hi this is Paul a friend of ██████████s. He wanted me to ask you to please call his attorney ██████████ at ██████████. He said he loves and misses you and his heart is broken. He asked if you could do that as soon as possible please."

Affiant searched the Securus jail phone system and found ██████████ placed a call to Paul's phone number. Affiant reviewed this call and heard ██████████ give Paul the instruction to send this message. He instructed Paul to emphasize it was "emergent". ██████████ was cautious not use the victim's name but it was obvious from the context he was speaking about the victim. He said, "The sooner you can do that the sooner I can get the fuck out of here".

During the strangulation investigation the victim reported at that time she and ██████████ dated for over a year and also lived together. In her Assault Victim Statement from that case the victim answered yes to the below 5 of 13 Lethality Screening questions:

- Has he ever tried to choke you?
- Is he violently or constantly jealous or does he control most of your daily activities?
- Has he ever tried to kill himself?
- Does he follow or spy on you or leave you threatening messages?
- Is there anything else that worries you about your safety? (reply: him hurting her and spying on her)

During the prior investigation the victim also reported ██████████ also assaulted her in approximately July of 2018 and that assault also included acts of strangulation. Affiant previously obtained a warrant charging ██████████ with violating this same EPO through a third party on 6/16/2019. Affiant also received information on 7/8/2019 a third party continued to relay messages from ██████████

██████████'s CCH records show the below convictions:

- Assault Causes Bodily Injury Family Member
- Possess Controlled Substance
- Kidnapping
- Robbery

An investigation of this incident revealed ██████████ committed an offense when he intentionally or knowingly through a third party, contacted a protected party of an Emergency Protective Order issued on the basis of family violence, when he knew the Order prohibited him from all communication outside of an attorney or person appointed by the Court.



The victim told him he was not allowed at her home and referenced a protective order would be set for a period of 31-91 days. ██████████ acknowledge the stay away order and volunteered the Order is through 10/30/2020 and he had the paperwork. The victim instructed him to make plans to move permanently.

In this call Affiant heard ██████████:

- Dispute the victim's statement it was "too late"
- State he wouldn't "do bad" anymore
- State he would work on himself
- Ask the victim for help contacting his friends related to bonding him out
- Argue with the victim when she told him not to come to her home stating he needed to retrieve his belongings

Affiant knows through her training and experience these are common statements of abusers who attempt to manipulate the victim, attempt to continue the power and control dynamic, and attempt to influence their victim often to aid them in avoiding criminal consequence for their actions.

During the phone conversation Affiant heard the victim tell ██████████ repeatedly he was not welcome at her home and said she could no longer tolerate his behavior and that it was "killing" her. In an Assault Victim Statement completed on 8/30/2020, the victim answered yes to the below questions:

- Has the suspect ever threatened if you call the police? (Reply: I'll fuck you up" – stated tonight)
- Were you prohibited from making an emergency call for assistance? (Reply: broken phone a few months ago)
- Do you want an Emergency Protective Order issued to the suspect?

The victim also answered yes to the below 7 of 13 Lethality Screening questions:

- Has he ever tried to choke you? (Reply: a couple of weeks)
- Is he violently or constantly jealous or does he control most of your daily activities?

- Do you have a child that he knows is not his?
- Does he follow or spy on you or leave threatening messages?
- Is there anything else that worries you about your safety? (Reply: Climbs through windows)

Affiant, K. Orts #1254, is a Detective, employed by the Travis County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Family Violence Unit. These events described did occur in Travis County, Texas. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff's Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

Travis County Sheriff's Office records show deputies responded to 1720 W Wells Branch Pkwy on 5/10/2021 after a 911 call was received from the victim (M. N., female, age 30) who reported she was assaulted by her boyfriend, [REDACTED] (male, age 37). Affiant reviewed information which indicated the victim and [REDACTED] had been in a dating relationship for 3 years, were living together at the incident location, and are the biological parents of a young son. The investigation resulted in Affiant filing charges against [REDACTED] charging him with Assault Family/Household Member with Previous Conviction in cause # D1DC21100034.

Affiant reviewed records which indicated [REDACTED] was arrested on this warrant in Williamson County on 1/16/2022. Subsequent to his arrest, Williamson County Magistrate E. Izaguirre issued an Emergency Protective Order (EPO) in the above cause on 1/17/2022 to remain in effect through 4/18/2022. In addition to standard restrictions, Judge Izaguirre ordered [REDACTED] to have no communication with the victim. Judge Izaguirre's signature witnessed [REDACTED] sign he received a copy of the EPO on 1/17/2022.

Affiant searched the Securus jail phone system using the victim's known phone number and discovered 56 calls to her number from 2/24/2022 - 2/28/2022 placed from [REDACTED]'s account while he was confined at the jails located at 500 W 11th Street, Austin, TX and 3614 Bill Price Rd, Del Valle, TX. The associated account information is registered to the victim's name and address. Affiant reviewed a portion of each call and recognized the victim as the called party based on his use of her nickname, her mention of her known job, her mention of her son by name, and Affiant's direct communication with the victim on multiple occasions.

In the portions of the calls Affiant reviewed, [REDACTED]'s statements to the victim included the below statements. Affiant knows through her training and experience statements of these types are common for abusers who attempt to continue to manipulate and control their victim and to procure the victim's help in helping them avoid a criminal consequence.

- Told the victim he loved her multiple times
- Was crying
- Complained about the jail conditions
- Promised to get her a gift for her birthday if he was still in jail
- Discussed a "paper" stating he would have her deliver it to a specific court once he knew where his was assigned
- Told her, "I want you to come see me" and said he knew she would.

Over the course of multiple investigations the victim reported [REDACTED]'s abusive acts toward her have included grabbing her by the waist and forcing her back inside their residence, strangling her, chasing her, taking her keys, pulling her hair, deflating her tires, assaulting her while pregnant, and threatening to post sex videos of her on the internet. The below is information gathered through the review of Travis County Sheriff's Office records and/or information gathered directly by Affiant.

On 5/8/2018, Deputy Boissennault responded to ██████████ after receiving a call for service from the victim (T B-G, female, age 51) who reported she received a letter from her former boyfriend, ██████████ (male, age 52). Jail records show ██████████ is currently incarcerated at the correctional complex in Del Valle after being arrested on 4/28/2018 and charged with Aggravated Assault with Deadly Weapon – Family Violence. Affiant review the EPO subsequently issued showing the victim as a protected part and ██████████ as the Defendant.
