Definition: Direction collaboration between Law Enforcement Officers & Prosecutors on individual

case by case and issue by issue situations

Goals: Protecting victims & holding offenders accountable

Mindset: Find your people. Change your mindset.

Changing the relationship from adversarial to a team mindset.

Converse regularly

Be open to difficult conversations

Establish expectations and meet them

Build Trust and reliability

Be self-aware enough to know your strengths & weaknesses

Get on the same page

Be willing to do the work

Establish a baseline for case staffings

Staff cases regularly

Be accessible

Solve problems together

Train together to get and give more educations

Provide accurate and frequent case updates

Continue to develop the relationship & be a support system

Stay on the same page

Stay willing to do the work

Ask the why

Explain the why

Explore strategies together

Expand the lens of what is collected

Understand how the information collected can be used for prosecution triage

Understand how the information can be used at trial – Guilt/Innocence & **Punishment**

We may never know how that information can connect so be thorough

Discuss and explore strategies for handling Motions to Increase Bond

Discuss and explore strategies for handling complex cases (example: Harassment - Stalking)

Assess the cases

Develop charging strategies

See positive trends in results

Incorporate strengths as a standard

- Further investigations after cases are filed
- Find errors and ways to correct them in the case itself and systemically
- Be able to further prosecution despite the case issues
- Find new offenses if the original charge is no longer viable

- Improve reports, investigations and documentation to increase better prosecution opportunities
- Learn new tools
- Discover new problems. Create & share solutions
- Report writing matters
- Teach prosecutors on-scene protocols
- Teach law enforcement rules of evidence
