BE MINDFUL OF YOUR DEMEANOR SLOW DOWN CALM THE CHAOS

CAPTURE THE EXPERIENCE

KEEP ALL PARTIES SEPARATED

IDENTIFY ALL PARTIES (even those who left)

INTERVIEW INDEPENDENTLY

CONSIDER FORENSIC INTERVIEWS FOR JUVENILES

IS MIRANDA NEEDED?

INTERVIEW ALL 911 CALLERS

ASK OPEN-ENDED & NON-LEADING QUESTIONS

CLARIFY CONFUSING LANGUAGE

CONTINUE ASKING QUESTIONS UNTIL YOU GET A CLEAR PICTURE

INVESTIGATE BEYOND WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN, WHY, HOW

ASK SENSORY QUESTIONS – CAPTURE THEIR EXPERIENCE

INVESTIGATE FEAR & DYNAMICS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

USE A VICTIM STATEMENT FORM AS AN INVESTIGATIVE GUIDE

ASK LETHALITY SCREENING QUESTIONS

BE HUMAN-CENTRIC

RECORD ALL CONTACT WITH THE PARTIES

PAY ATTENTION TO WHAT IS SAID & HOW IT IS SAID

PAY ATTENTION TO WHAT ISN'T SAID

BE ALERT FOR NON-RESPONSIVE RESPONSES

SCENE DOCUMENTATION

YOU ONLY GET ONE CHANCE AT A FRESH SCENE

"FOUR CORNERS" PHOTOS PHOTOGRAPH EVIDENCE IN PLACE
BEFORE MOVING

PHOTOGRAPH EVIDENCE IN CONTEXT

RECORD THE SCENE DOCUMENTATION

PERSON DOCUMENTATION

FULL BODY
TO SHOW PERSPECTIVE

CLOSE UP OF INJURIES

PHOTOGRAPH A LACK OF INJURY

DO NOT DELETE
BAD PHOTOS - SUBMIT ALL

FLEEING SUSPECT ASK FOR A PHOTO

CORROBORATION

EVIDENCE OF THE CRIME

EVIDENCE OF THE FAMILY RELATIONSHIP

EVIDENCE OF TRUTHFUL STATEMENTS EVIDENCE OF DECEPTIVE STATEMENTS

EVIDENCE

COLLECT ALL PYSICAL EVIDENCE AT THE SCENE

PHOTOGRAPH MESSAGES, CALL LOGS, VIDEOS, ETC

AND/OR HAVE THEM SEND TO YOU WHILE STILL ON SCENE

LOOK FOR ELECTRONIC EVIDENCE SOURCES

COLLECT EVIDENCE OF EVENTS LEADING UP TO, DURING, AND AFTER AN EVENT

911 CALLS & DISPATCH NOTES

REVIEW DISPATCH NOTES PRIOR TO CONCLUDING AN ON-SCENE INVESTIGATION

CONSIDER REQUESTING & REVIEWING THE 911 CALL PRIOR TO CONCLUDING THE ON-SCENE INVESTIGATION

DETECTIVES RESPONDING TO A SCENE SHOULD REVIEW THE DISPATCH NOTES AND 911 CALL PRIOR TO THE SCENE INVESTIGATION AND PRIOR TO INTERVIEWING THE PARTIES

911 CALLS & DISPATCH NOTES

911 CALLS & DISPATCH NOTES SHOULD BE ARCHIVED FOR EVERY ARREST

CONSIDER ARCHIVING 911 CALLS AND DISPATCH NOTES FOR ALL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE EVENTS (including non-criminal events)

RETENTION PERIODS FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RELATED EVENTS SHOULD NOT EXPIRE

INCIDENT REPORTS

NOTE ANY CAUTIONS AT THE TOP OF YOUR NARRATIVE

NOTE RELATED INCIDENT NUMBERS AT THE TOP OF YOUR NARRATIVE

DOCUMENT OBSERVATIONS

AVOID COMBINING THE TOTAL REPORTED EVENTS INTO ONE SUMMARY

DOCUMENT WHAT EACH PARTY REPORTED SEPARTELY (even if the same info)

INCIDENT REPORTS

WRITE ACCURATE DEPICTIONS

BE MINDFUL OF AND OMIT JUDGMENTAL LANGUAGE

BE SURE TO NOTE YOUR ACTIONS

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATIONS

TRIAGE FOR ONGOING SAFETY

REVIEW THE 911 CALL & DISPATCH NOTES FOR EVERY CASE

REVIEW ON-SCENE REPORTS AND/OR BODY CAMERA VIDEO

REVIEW PHOTOS

REQUEST AND REVIEW EMS PATIENT CARE REPORTS

SEARCH CRIMINAL HISTORY - RAP SHEETS

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATIONS

SEARCH INTERNAL RECORDS FOR PRIOR EVENTS

SEARCH DISPATCH NOTES FOR PRIOR EVENTS (search by address & phone numbers even if the incident number is known)

CONSIDER SENDING RECORDS CHECK REQUESTS TO OTHER AGENCIES WHERE PARTIES HAVE LIVED

COORDINATE WITH PROSECUTORS WHEN THERE ARE PENDING CASES

RECORD ALL FOLLOW UP INTERVIEWS

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATIONS

ASK ABOUT WHAT HAS OCCURRED SINCE THE POLICE CONTACT

COLLECT ANY ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE

CONSIDER FOLLOW UP PHOTOS
INJURIES SOMETIMES BECOME VISIBLE LATER
TO SHOW A PROGRESSION OF THE INJURIES

PHOTOGRAPH ANY NEW OCCURENCES SINCE THE ORIGINAL EVENT

REQUEST MEDICAL RECORDS (consent, subpoena, search warrant)

EXPLORE OTHER SUBPOENA AND/OR SEARCH WARRANT OPPORTUNITIES

HISTORICALS

INCLUDE SUMMARIES OF PAST EVENTS INTO THE NEW NARRATIVE

ARCHIVE PAST EVENTS WITH THE NEW EVENT CASE FILES

BE AWARE PRIOR CONVICTIONS FOR CHARGE ENHANCEMENTS

POST ARREST

RESEARCH
WHETHER
PROTECTIVE
ORDERS
WERE
ISSUED

CONSIDER IN-PERSON COMPLIANCE CHECKS ARCHIVE, MONITOR, AND REVIEW JAIL CALLS

CONSIDER COVERT ALERTS

MONITOR
JAIL
MESSAGING
& MAIL

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVITS

AVOID USING FULL NAMES OTHER THAN THE DEFENDANT'S

AVOID USING EXACT ADDRESSES - USE BLOCK RANGES INSTEAD

INTRODUCE THE FAMILY RELATIONSHIP

DESCRIBE HOW THE CALL INITIATED

INDEPENDENTLY DESCRIBE WHAT EACH PARTY REPORTED

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVITS

INCLUDE LETHALITY RISK FACTORS

INCLUDE OTHER CURRENT AND PAST DANGEROUS ACTS


INCLUDE QUOTED STATEMENTS AND/OR TEXT MESSAGES

INCLUDE CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS

USE BULLET POINT LISTS FOR INJURIES AND OTHER NON-NARRATIVE INFORMATION

THOROUGH INVESTIGATIONS CAN SOMETIMES ALLOW FOR THE PROSECUTION OF CRIMES WITHOUT A VICTIM'S PARTICIPATION

THIS HELPS HOLD OFFENDERS ACCOUNTABLE WITH THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF KEEPING VICTIMS SAFE.
