NARRATIVE

On April 16, 2025, I, Deputy A. Sanchez #14754, responded to 1234 Sunshine Way for an Emotionally Disturbed Person call later changed to Terroristic Threat.

Dispatch advised the caller,
Daniels, Alli W/F DOB: 8/22/1998

called 911 while hiding in a closet. Daniels reported she and her boyfriend,

Barton, Davis W/M DOB: 2/14/1996

were in a verbal argument when he threatened to kill her, her dog, and himself. He then walked out to his truck where she believed he was going to retrieve a gun to carry out his threat.

When I arrived on scene, I saw Barton walking from behind the house. I immediately gave him commands to see his hands and to get on the ground. He immediately complied and I held him a gunpoint until other units could arrive to assist in securing him. Barton had a

in the waistband in the small of his back. He was detained in my patrol unit for scene safety. I informed Barton he wasn't under arrest but I provided him his Miranda rights. This was recorded via my Axon in-car camera system.

Barton stated the gun was not his and that it belonged to a friend who lives in San Antonio and he'd just returned from the friend's ranch after a weekend with his friend group where they were shooting guns. He brought the gun home because he was thinking about buying one and he claimed he was merely bringing it inside because he didn't want to leave it in his vehicle.

I went inside the residence and met with Deputy T. Jameson #13162 who said he found Daniels in the primary bedroom closet with her dog, "Frankie".

Daniels told me the following. Barton came home intoxicated after being away a couple days with his friends in San Antonio. He accused she'd cheated on him while he was away and their verbal argument escalated when he threatened to kill her, Frankie, and himself. He stated, "Alli, I've literally been shooting guns all weekend. You think I don't know how to use one. I'll end it for all of us right now." He then made a gesture with his right hand to represent a gun and he pointed his figurative gun at Frankie, at Daniels, and then his own head. He then walked outside to toward his truck. As he walked away he said something to the effect of her forcing him to "do this" and that this wasn't how he thought "things would end".

Daniels was immediately fearful he was going to get a gun from his truck. He'd told her on the way home his buddy let him bring one home to see if it might be a good fit for him to purchase. She didn't see him bring it in and assumed it was still in his truck. She locked the door behind Barton and she immediately fled to the closet where she called 911. She heard sounds that led her to believe he was walking around the house trying to gain entry through multiple doors and windows.

Daniels confirmed she was not injured. I attempted to completed a domestic violence victim statement with her but she said she was took shaken up. She called a friend who came to stay with her. Alli said she would likely go spend the night with the friend. I gave her a Victim/Witness Booklet and told her I would ask someone from Victim Services give her a call the following day.

I informed Barton he was being arrested and he was insistent he hadn't done anything wrong. He denied being suicidal or making any threats. I tried to ask him more details about the evening but he just repeated these same statements over and over. His breath had a faint smell of alcohol and he appeared to be under the influence of an unknown substance. I found a small baggie with the residue of white powdery substance in his front right pocket. Not knowing what the substance had been and with no usable amount, I photographed the baggie and submitted it for destruction.

I transported Barton to Central Booking. While en route he continued to declare he'd done nothing wrong and said Daniels was trying to set him up.

I completed a probable cause affidavit charging Barton with Terroristic Threat – Family Violence and submitted it to jail staff with a Notification of Victim Form and a Motion for an Emergency Protective Order.

Photos and video were archived through Axon with this case number.

Case cleared by Patrol Arrest.
