Background

- 4 (3") squares, label B (HST's)
- 2 (2 1/2") squares, label A
- 2 (3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>") squares, cut on 1 diagonal, label C

## Green 1

- 4 (2 ½") squares, label A
- 2 (3") squares, label B (HST's)


## Green 2

- 2 (3") squares, label B (HST's)
- 2 (2 1/2") squares, label A
- 2 (1" x 4") rectangles, label D (stem)

#### **Block Construction**


1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each Background B square. Match each Background B square to a Green 1 and Green 2 with RST. Stitch a ¼" seam on both sides of the drawn line. Cut each apart on the drawn line. Open and press each HST. Trim each to (2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>")

Make (4) Green 1 HST's, and (4) Green 2 HST's.










Background C Triangles are oversized for easier piecing of the Stem.

#### 2. Stem. (a light gray frame added to both pictures)

- a) Fold the Green 2 D rectangle in half along the length and crease or mark the center.
- b) Fold and crease the center of the Background C Triangles along the longest edge.
- c) Align with RST the Green 2 rectangle center crease to the Background C triangle crease.
- d) Sew.
- e) Aligning with RST the other Background C triangle crease to Green 2 D rectangle.
- f) Sew and Press.
- g) Repeat steps a-f to make another Stem.
- h) Trim both to (2 ½" x 2 ½")



- 3. Layout as shown.
  - a) Match with RST and join the units for each Row.
  - b) Press
  - c) Match Block Row 1 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press
  - d) Match Block Row 3 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press
  - e) Make 2 blocks, Size: 6 ½" x 6 ½"
