Make 2

Block size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Technique: Tri-square triangles, bias triangles

Bias Triangles: prepare fabric before cutting with

Spray Starch.

Cutting:

Background

- 8 (2 1/2") squares, label A
- 2 (3 1/4") squares, cut on both diagonals, label B

Purple

• 4 (3") squares, cut on ONE diagonal, label C

Lavendar

• 2 (3 1/4") squares, cut on both diagonals, label B

Yellow

• 2 (2 ½") squares, label A

Block Construction:

1. Match with RST and join, each Background B triangle to each Lavendar B triangle. These are directional. Layout triangles as shown, Sew with the Lavendar triangle on top.

Open and press. Label B/B Make 8






2. Match with RST and join a Purple C triangle to each B/B from Step 1. Sew, open, press and trim. Trim each to 2 ½" x 2 ½". Tip: Trim only from the Purple triangle.












Technique: working with Bias Triangles

- Always sew with RST (Right Sides Together)
- Pressing Seam Allowance Arrows are in black and orange
- WOF: Width of Fabric

Finishing the Block

1. Layout as shown. Match with RST and join each unit for each row. Press.

Match with RST Row 1 to Row 2. Open and press. Next, Match with RST, Row 3 to Row 2. Open and press. Make 2, Size: $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
