## <mark>Bias triangles</mark>:

(Optional) Use spray starch on fabrics before cutting.

**Note**: I added one more blue fabric to my FQ selection of blues. You don't need to, I just wanted a lighter blue in the block.

# Cutting:

Background

- 8 (2") squares, label A
- 2 (4 ¼") squares, cut on BOTH diagonals, label B (Bias Triangles)

### Dark Blue

• 4 (2 ¾") squares, cut on BOTH diagonals, label C (Bias Triangles)

## **Bright Blue**


• 4 (2 ¾") squares, cut on BOTH diagonals, label C (Bias Triangles)

Light Blue (new blue, see **Note**)

• 2 (3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>") squares, label D

#### **Block Construction:**

1. Divide the Dark Blue and Bright Blue C Triangles into two groups: 8 Dark Blue and 8 Bright Blue in each group. One group will be the left and the other will be the right star points.






- 2. Layout as shown, both Dark Blue and Bright Blue C triangles.
  - a. Starting with the left group, Match with RST, placing the Bright Blue<sup>NancyMcNallyquilts.com</sup> C triangle on top of the Dark Blue C triangle.
  - b. Match the Corner of the triangles. Keeping the Dark Blue C Triangle on the bottom.
  - Sew, leading with the corner. TIP: Place a scrap piece of the fabric under the presser foot sew a few stitches on this scrap fabric and sew OFF the scrap. Now place the C triangles under the presser foot and begin sewing.
  - d. Sew all 8 from the left group.
  - e. Press Seam Allowance, pressing arrow is in WHITE
  - f. For the Right Group:
  - g. Match with RST, place each Dark Blue C triangle on top of each Bright Blue.
  - h. Matching the corner of the triangles. Keeping the Dark Blue on TOP.
  - i. Sew, leading with the corner. **Don't forget the TIP from above**. Sew all 8 from the Right Group.



3. Match with RST, each Left Star Point as shown to each Background B Triangle. Align the tip of the Dark Blue Left triangle to the Left tip of the Background B Triangle as shown. Sew and Press. The Tip of the Bright Blue Triangle will go past the Background B Triangle. Make 8



4. Repeat step with the Right Group of C Triangles to the Background B Triangles. Sew and press. Make 8. Size 2" x 3 ½"







Finishing the Block

 Layout as shown. Match with RST a Background A square to the left and right sides of (4) Flying Geese. Sew and press. Make 4 Size: (Top and Bottom Rows) <u>2" x 6 ½"</u>





2. Match with RST a Flying Geese to the left and right sides of the Light Blue D square. Sew and press. Make 2. Size: (Center Row) 3 ½" x 6 ½".



3. Match with RST a Top and Bottom Row to the Center Row as shown. Sew and Press. Make 2, Block size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
