- Always sew with a ¼" seam allowance
- Always sew with RST (Right Sides Together)
- Pressing Seam Allowance Arrows are in black and orange
- WOF: Width of Fabric

Block size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Technique: 2@Time HST's

Cutting

Background

- 6 (2 1/2") squares, label A
- 6 (3") squares, label B (HST's)

From Each of the Following: Pink, Purple, Teal (or Green)

• 2 (3") squares, label B (HST's)

Block Construction

- Draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the back of each of the Background B squares.
- 2. Match with RST, each Background B square to a Pink, Purple, Teal B square.
- Stitch a ¼" away on both sides of the diagonal line.
 Cut apart on the diagonal line. Open each HST and press.
 Trim each HST to (2 ½" x 2 ½")



- 4. Layout as shown.
 - a) Match with RST and join the units for each Row.
 - b) Press
 - c) Match Block Row 1 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press
 - d) Match Block Row 3 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press
 - e) Make 2 blocks, Size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
