Block size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Technique: 8@Time HST's and Strip Set

Cutting

Background

1 (1 ½" x 20 ½") rectangle (strip), label B

1 (6") square, label A

Green

• 1 (6") square, label A

Orange


• 1 (1 ½" x 20 ½") rectangle (strip), label B

Pink (my pink looks more red)

• 2 (2 ½") square, label C

Block Construction

- 1. Making the Strip Set B/B. Match and join with RST the Background B strip to the Orange B strip. Open and press seam allowance. Strip Set should measure (2 1/2" wide x 20 1/2" long)
 - a) Cut the Strip Set B/B into (8) (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") units, label B/B




2. 8@Time HST. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner, making an X, on the backside of the Background A square. Next, draw a line from top to bottom and side to side, dividing the block in half at the 3" mark, making a plus sign 🖶



- Always sew with RST (Right Sides
- Together)

Technique: working with Bias Triangles


- Pressing Seam Allowance Arrows are in black and orange
- WOF: Width of Fabric




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- 3. Match with RST the Green A square to the Background A square.
 - a) Stitch a ¼" away from the DIAGONALLY drawn lines ONLY, On both sides of the DIAGONAL lines.
 - b) Cut apart on All of the Drawn lines: Yield (8) HST's
 - c) Open and Press.
 - d) Trim each HST to (2 1/2" x 2 1/2")







- 4. Finishing the Block. Layout as shown.
 - a) Match with RST and join the units for each Row.
 - b) Press
 - c) Match Block Row 1 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press
 - d) Match Block Row 3 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press
 - e) Make 2 blocks, Size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
