Block Size with Frame: 18 1/2" x 18 1/2"

### **Supply List**

Background

Red

Green

Dark Blue

Coral

Yellow

Bias Triangle, prepare using Spray Starch on the Coral and Background C squares.

The Market Square Block uses (3) different methods for making HST's.

The methods are: 8@Time, 4@Time, 2@Time



### **Cutting**

### Background

- 3 (6") squares, label A
- 2 (2 1/2") squares, label B
- 1 (4 ½") square, label C, Bias
- 1 (3") square, label D
- 16 (1 1/2") squares, label E
- 8 (1 ½" x 12 ½") rectangles, label F (Frame strip set)

## Background #2

- 2 (2 1/2") squares, label B
- 1 (3") square, label D (HST)

From each of the following:

#### Green and Red

- 1 (6") square, label A
- 2 (2 ½") squares, label B
- 4 (1 1/2") squares, label E

### Coral

- 1 (4 ½") square, label C, Bias
- 4 (1 ½") squares, label E

#### Green

• 4 (1 ½" x 12 ½") rectangles, label F (Frame Strip Set)



#### Dark Blue

- 1 (6") square, label A
- 4 (1 ½") squares, label E


#### Yellow

- 1 (3") square, label D (HST)
- 4 (1 1/2") squares, label E




#### **Block Construction**

- 1. Beginning with the 8@Time HST method. Draw (2) diagonal lines making an X on the back of each Background A square. Next, divide each background square in half by drawing a line from top to bottom in the center and side to side creating a Plus (+) sign.
  - Match with RST each Background square to a Red, Green and Dark Blue A square.
  - b) Stitch a 1/4" away on both sides of the DIAGONAL LINES ONLY
  - c) Cut apart on the Drawn Lines, both diagonal and center lines
  - d) Open each HST and Press.
  - e) Trim each to (2 ½" x 2 ½"), Makes (8) of each color combination



- 2. Next HST method: Bias HST. Match Background C to Coral C squares with RST.
  - a) Stitch a ¼" away from the outer edges, all four sides.
  - b) Cut apart on both diagonals
  - c) Open and press each HST
  - d) Trim each to (2 1/2" x 2 1/2")





- 3. Final method for making HST: 2@Time. The 2@Time method is the more common method.
  - a) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of the Background D square.
  - b) Match with RST the Background D square to the Yellow D square.
  - c) Stitch a 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line.
  - d) Cut apart on the drawn line
  - e) Open and press
  - f) Trim each to (2 1/2" x 2 1/2")












## **Bring it together**

- 1. Layout as shown. Press all seam allowances OPEN
  - a) Match with RST and Sew the units for each row. Press
  - b) Match Block Row 1 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press.
  - c) Match Block Row 3 to Block Row 2, Sew and Press.
  - d) Match Block Row 4 to Block Row 3, Sew and Press
  - e) Match Block Row 5 to Block Row 4, Sew and Press
  - f) Match Block Row 6 to Block Row 4, Sew and Press
  - g) Match and Sew all the Rows together to finish the Block
  - h) Press. Size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"







## Frame Market Square Block

- 1. Match with RST and Sew the following to make (4) strip sets.
  - a) Background Frame Strip Set rectangle to both sides, along the length, of a Green Frame Strip rectangle.
  - b) Make 4, Size: (3 1/2" x 12 1/2")



- 2. Making the (4) Nine Patch Inner Border Corner Blocks
  - a) Layout the Background E squares, Red, Navy Blue, Yellow and Coral E squares as shown.
  - b) Match with RST, each of the block row E squares, Sew and press.
  - c) Match with RST and Sew Row 1 to Row 2
  - d) Press
  - e) Match with RST and Sew Row 2 to Row 3
  - f) Press
  - g) Make 4, Size 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 3. Match with RST and Sew a Nine Patch Block to both ends of (2) Framed Strip Set.





## 4. Layout as shown

- a) Match with RST and Sew a Framed Strip Set to the Sides of the Market Square Block
- b) Press
- c) Match with RST and Sew a Nine Patch/Framed Strip Set to the Top & Bottom of the Market Square Block
- d) Press, Size: 18 1/2" x 18 1/2"
