Patch-n-Dash a Block of the Week

Block 1: Churn Dash

Block size: 6" x 6" finished size

Make: 8

Technique: 8@Time HST (HST: Half Square Triangle)

- Always sew with a ¼" seam allowance
- Always sew with RST (Right Sides Together)
- Pressing Seam Allowance Arrows are in black
- WOF: Width of Fabric

## **Cutting:**

White/background fabric

- 2 (1 ½" x WOF) strips, sub cut into (8) 1 ½" x 10" rectangles, label B
- 4 (6") squares, label A (8@Time HST)

#### Yellow

• 4 (1 1/2" x WOF) strips, sub cut into (8) 1 1/2" x 10" rectangles, label B

## Light Blue


• 8 (2 ½") squares, label C

From each: Orange, Purple, Red, Green

• 1 (6") square, label A


#### **Block Construction:**

- 1. Draw two diagonal lines from corner to corner, forming an X on the back of each White A square. Next, draw a line to divide the block in half both top to bottom and side to side.
- 2. With RST, match each White A square to an Orange A, Purple A, Red A and Green A square.
- On each pair, stitch a ¼" away from the DIAGONALLY drawn lines, on both sides of the DIAGONALLY drawn lines. See picture below.
- 4. Cut in half along the black lines, both horizontally and vertically. Then, cut along both diagonal drawn lines. Open the HSTs and press the seam allowance towards the darker fabric.
- 5. Trim each HST to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". Make a total of 32, HST's





- 6. With RST, match each White B rectangle to a Yellow B rectangle.
- 7. Join together, creating (8) pairs. Press seam allowances.
- 8. Cut each strip pair into (4) 2 ½" sections.
- 9. Total (32), Size: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Pulling it all together

- 1. Follow these steps to make (8) Churn Dash Quilt Blocks. Each Block will measure (6 1/2" x 6 1/2")
- 2. Layout for each block as shown. Join each block row, RST, and press seam allowances.
- 3. Gather the following for each block: Orange, Purple, Red, Green HST, White/Yellow square, Light Blue C square.
- 4. After creating each row, match and sew row 1 to row 2, and finish by sewing row 3 to row 2. Press seam allowances.
