Technique/Skill: Bias Triangles

Cutting:

Background

- 8 (1 ¾") squares, label A
- 4 (2-3/8") squares, cut on both diagonals,
- 8 (1 ¾" x 2-7/8") rectangles, label C

From both Red & Green

2 (2-3/8") squares, cut on both diagonals, label B

Pink


• 4 (3 ½") squares, cut on ONE diagonal, label D

Purple

2 (1 ¾") squares, label A


Block Construction:

- 1. These are Tiny shapes. Match with RST and join the following, see pictures, these are directional. The Green is on the left side of the corner section and the red is on the right corner section. Make (8) each: Background B/Green B triangles and Background B/Red B triangle sets
- 2. Match with RST, the Green/Background triangle to each Background A square. Aligning to the corner where the Green/Background triangle have come together, see blue arrows. Sew and Press.



Notes & Abbreviations

- Always sew with a 1/4" seam allowance
- Always sew with RST (Right Sides Together)
- Pressing Seam Allowance Arrows are in black, orange or white
- WOF: Width of Fabric
- Prepare highlighted fabrics, before cutting with spray starch for stability while sewing







3. Match with RST, the Red/Background triangle to the other side of the Background A square, see picture. Sew, press. Make 8









4. Fold each Pink D triangle in half and crease center with fingers or iron. Match with RST, each Pink D triangle to each triangle from the previous step. Align the center crease mark to the intersection of the Green/Red triangles. Make 8 Corner sections. Trim to 2-7/8" x 2-7/8"







Finishing the Block:

1. Layout Corners, Background C rectangles, and Purple A square. Match and join with RST, Row 1, Row 2 and Row 3 units in each row. Press. Next, with RST, match Row 2 to Row 1. Sew and press. Match Row 3 to Row 2. Sew and press. Block size: 6 ½" X 6 ½", Make 2.
