Make 2

Block size: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Technique: 2@Time HST's

Cutting

Background

- 8 (2 ½") squares, label A
- 4 (3") squares, label B

Yellow

• 2 (2 ½") squares, label A

From each of the following: Orange, Green, Pink, Lavendar

• 1 (3") square, label B


Block Construction


- 1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on The back side of each Background B square.
- 2. With RST, match each Background B square to an Orange, Lavendar, Pink, Green B square. Stitch ¼" on either side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Open each HST and Press. Makes 2 HST of each color. Trim each HST to (2 ½" x 2 ½")




3. Layout as shown. Place Background A squares in the four outer corners, Yellow A Square in the very center. Match and sew the units in each row, press. Next, Sew the rows together to complete the Friendship Star Block. Make 2. Size: 6 ½" x 6 ½"









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Technique: working with Bias Triangles

- Always sew with a ¼" seam allowance
- Always sew with RST (Right Sides Together)
- Pressing Seam Allowance Arrows are in black and orange
- WOF: Width of Fabric
