#### Please read:

- The cutting instructions for each Quilt Block will be listed at the beginning of that Quilt Block.
- The color suggestions for each quilt block are just suggestions, you can choose any color combinations you would like. A coloring block is available for each, along with a blank coloring image for the quilt.
- Each New Block will be released on Monday morning by 9am EST
- Mondays are also Maintenance Monday. Take the time to show your sewing machine some love. Clean out the bobbin space, put a new needle in, wipe the lint away from the needle bar, clean the screen. Don't forget to also clean your iron and put a new rotary cutter blade into your rotary cutter.
- Start the project with a new needle.
- Always sew with Right Sides Together (RST)
- Always sew a quilt project with a ¼" seam allowance
- Gather fabrics and prepare by pressing the folds and creases.
- Basic sewing supplies will be needed: seam ripper, thread scissors, neutral thread, fabric marking pen, spray starch.
- Cutting for Bias Triangles will be highlighted in Yellow. Prepare fabric with Spray Starch BEFORE CUTTING.
- Abbreviations: HST-Half Square Triangles, RST-Right Sides Together, FG-Flying
  Geese, QST-Quarter Square Triangles, WOF-Width of Fabric, LOF-Length of Fabric
