EXAMPLE OF A CAPTAIN'S SCORECARD PREPARED FOR INDIVIDUAL PLAY (LG/LN) CARDS ARE NOT STROKED FOR INDIVIDUAL PLAY

CAPTAINS SHOULD PREPARE TWO OF THESE CARDS PRIOR TO PLAY – ONE FOR THE CAPTAIN AND ONE FOR THE CO-CAPTAIN. THEY SHOUD CONTAIN EACH PLAYERS FULL NAME, MEMBERSHIP NUMBER AND HANDICAP. ALL OF THESE ARE LISTED ON THE WEEKLY PAIRINGS SHEET WHICH IS EMAILED AND ON THE WEBSITE.



EXAMPLE OF A COMPLETED SCORECARD FOR INDIVIDUAL PLAY (LG/LN). ALL PLAYERS SCORES HAVE BEEN ENTERED AT EACH HOLE BY BOTH THE CAPTAIN AND THE CO-CAPTAIN. WHEN THE GAME IS OVER, THEY ARE TOTALLED AND THE GROSS SCORE IS PUT IN THE "TOT" COLUMN. THE HANDICAP IS SUBTRACTED AND THE NET SCORE IS PUT IN THE "NET" COLUMN. THE CAPTAIN AND ATTESTED BY THE CO-CAPTAIN. THE CAPTAINS CARD IS TURNED IN TO THE SCORING GROUP ALONG WITH THE \$2.25 THAT HAS BEEN COLLECTED FROM EACH PLAYER. CAPTAIN ALSO NOTES IF THERE WERE ANY CHIPINS OR BIRDIES, AND GIVES THE SCORERS THE NAMES OF THOSE INDIVIDUALS
